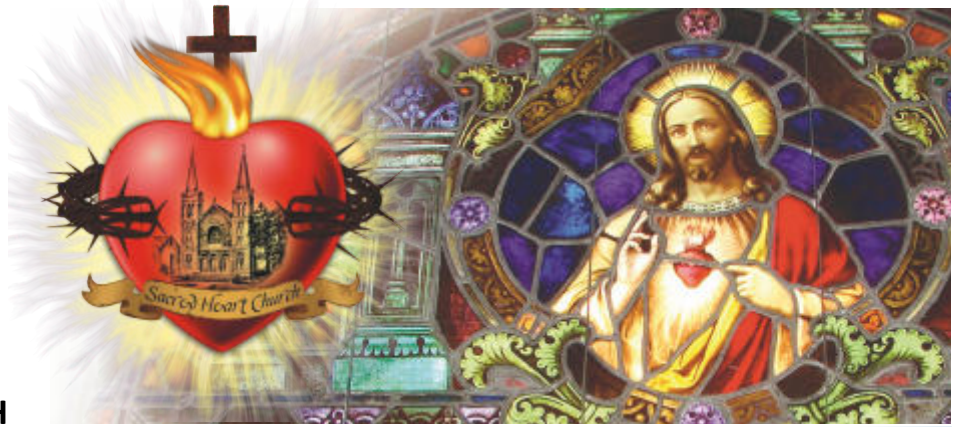

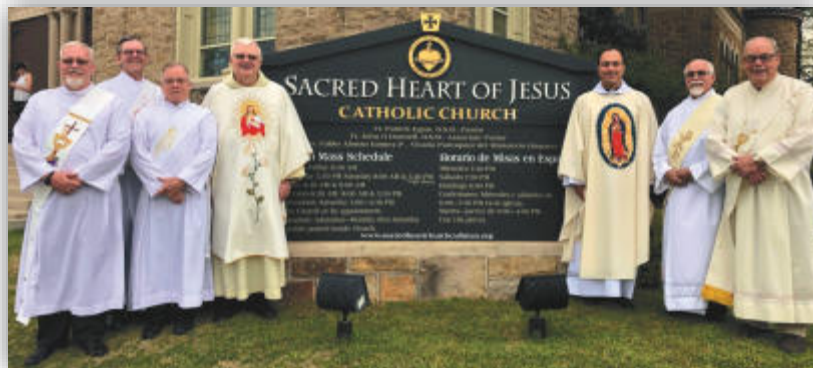

A Man for All Seasons

I'm fairly certain that everyone my age and older has seen the movie classic *A Man for All Seasons*, but you younger readers probably haven't. You should watch this old 1966 classic, because it tells the story of one of my favorite saints, Thomas More, and his conflict with King Henry VIII during England's Protestant revolt. The movie stars Paul Scofield as More, Orson Wells as Cardinal Wolsey, and Robert Shaw (*Jaws*) as the king. For those of you who haven't seen it, I'll give you the gist of the story here because it quite poignantly helps me cover this week's topic.

Henry was married to Catherine of Aragon, but he wanted the marriage annulled because she was unable to give birth to a male heir to the throne. Henry petitioned the Pope for an annulment, but the annulment was refused on the basis of theological reasons. So Henry, in his desire to divorce Catherine and marry Anne Boleyn, declared himself the head of the Church in England in 1559. And that was the start of the Protestant Revolt in England.

St. Thomas More was a lawyer and close friend of the King. Henry made Thomas the Chancellor of England. The conflict between the two men came with Henry declaring himself the head of the Church in England, thus displacing the God-given authority of the Pope. Thomas was thrown into prison because he refused to give in to Henry on the matter of the Oath of Supremacy, which all members of the King's court were required to sign to acknowledge Henry's supremacy over the Church. Thomas would never serve a king in the place of his God, even if it meant losing the highest office in the kingdom and even his life.

He showed this one morning when the Duke of Norfolk (Thomas' best friend) found him in a surplice serving Mass (as he very often did) and told him he was dishonoring the King. Thomas said, "Do you think that the King, your master and mine, will be offended with me for serving God, his master and mine?"

Thomas' wife was very worried about him. Obviously, she didn't want him to be beheaded by order of the King. While Thomas was imprisoned in the Tower of London, she visited him to persuade her husband to sign the Oath of Supremacy. The King would forgive him, she said, and he'd be able to live the rest of his life with his family in peace and honor.

"How much longer do you think I shall live?" asked Thomas.

"Why, a full twenty years yet," she replied.

"Twenty years!" he said gravely. "*And for the sake of another twenty years' comfort in this life you would have me throw away a happiness in the next world that would last forever and face the prospect of a life of endless misery? Surely, that would be a very bad bargain!*" Thomas didn't give up his faith, but gave his life for it. He was beheaded and became an English martyr.

More's biographers tell us that he heard Mass everyday before undertaking any other business. Today nuns, consecrated to perpetual adoration, kneel in the home of St. Thomas, that great lover of the Blessed Sacrament who left us this prayer: "Give me the grace to long for Thy holy sacraments, and especially to rejoice in the presence of Thy blessed body, sweet Savior Christ, in the holy Sacrament of the Altar."

If St. Thomas had consented to his wife's request, he would have committed a mortal sin by denying his faith. This would have, of course, kept him out of heaven. In the eyes of St. Thomas, all the world had to offer was nothing compared to heaven. You run the risk of losing heaven if you commit even one mortal sin that goes unreported and unconfessed.

Thomas More had a fear of mortal sin, as did most practicing Catholics in the 1500s. Fast forward 500 years to today's practicing Catholics. Based on surveys where Catholics have admitted things about themselves, the modern laity seem to think nothing much at all about committing mortal sin. Perhaps the two most prevalent mortal sins modern Catholics commit are artificial contraception (over 90%) and a denial of one or more truths of the Catholic faith (82%).

To condemn one's own soul to hell is one's own business. It shouldn't be any skin off of my nose, after all. Still, I'd be disobedient myself if I failed to warn you. Modern Catholics are certainly suffering from catechetical illiteracy, but that's no excuse for the commission of mortal sin. Natural law alone, something all people know in their hearts because God placed it there (Romans 2:15), tells you that artificial contraception is evil, which is why the Church has condemned it from the very first century, because it was common among the Romans.

Regarding denial of any one part of Catholic teaching Jesus Himself said, "Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned" (Mark 16:16). He commanded His apostles to teach everything He'd taught (Matthew 28:20), then made our salvation contingent upon our complete and full acceptance of those teachings. Still a majority of modern Catholics continue in their obstinacy to reject Christ's 2000 year deposit of the faith.

"Well, there are some things that I think shouldn't be accepted because the world is different from when Jesus was on earth," you might say.

Really? If you're the sort of person who'd say anything even remotely like that, I have one question for you: What makes you so arrogant that you think you can know more than God Himself? Jesus is God in His second Person of the Trinity, as we've proven many times before. As Paul says, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever," (Hebrews 13:8). Because God is perfect, He can't change. Therefore His laws can't change. If you're arrogant enough to believe that you can displace His laws with your own opinions, then you're walking into the abyss of hell, blinded by your own arrogance.

Accepting Catholic morality and living an authentic Catholic life requires courage. It requires a backbone. After all, comfort and conviction don't live on the same block, as I always say. And because all people were created for truth and to know truth, ignorance of moral truth is no excuse. The thing you should be asking yourself is whether you know the 2000 year constant teachings of the Catholic Church, the Church established by Christ. If you don't know *everything* the Church teaches, then you need to learn. After all, you can't live what you don't know. 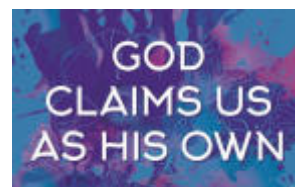

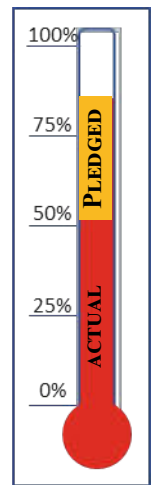

Espero ser como Él

"¿Quién es este Cristo? ¿Es como tú?"

Quizás hayas escuchado esta historia, a menudo atribuida a la vida de Santa Teresa de Calcuta. Un hombre enfermo le hizo esta pregunta, mientras se maravillaba de su incansable servicio para él y los demás en el nombre de alguien llamado Jesucristo.

"Él no se parece en nada a mí," se dice que respondió la santa. "Pero espero ser como Él."

Aunque no se puede verificar la autenticidad de este intercambio, su mensaje suena perfectamente cierto: todo el valor de nuestra corresponsabilidad radica en su relatividad con aquel en cuyo nombre lo realizamos.

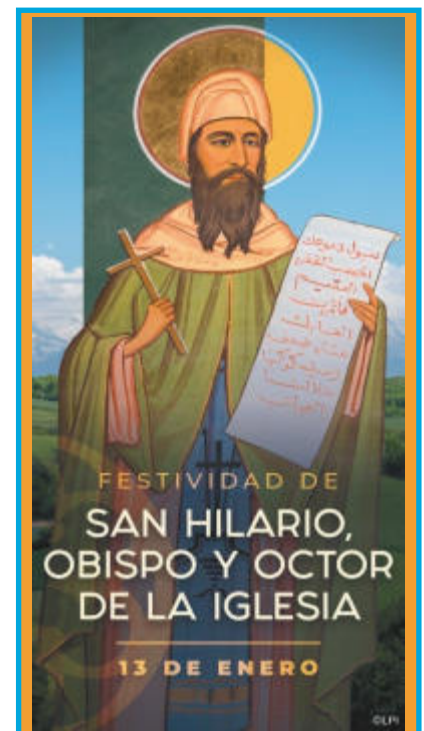
Considere la figura de Juan el Bautista, un personaje magnífico e imponente, incluso desde una perspectiva

puramente literaria o histórica. Un mártir que se alimentaba de langostas salvajes y con valentía le decía la verdad al poder; un hombre tan grande que algunos lo confundieron con el Mesías.

Pero ¿por qué es grandioso? Porque preparó el camino. Todos sus logros y aventuras no significan nada si se sacan del contexto de la historia de la salvación. Solo tiene sentido en relación con Cristo, y esto es exactamente como él lo quería. "Viene uno más digno que yo," insiste. Y debido a esa humildad y ese abrazo total de la voluntad de Dios, se le otorga uno de los mayores honores del Nuevo Testamento: bautiza al Hijo de Dios.

Examinemos nuestras vidas a la luz de su relatividad con Cristo. ¿Cómo preparamos el camino? Cuando Cristo viene a nosotros, ¿qué hacemos? ¿Cómo nos abrimos a ser actores en el plan de Dios?

«EL BAUTISMO DEL SEÑOR: EL DON Y LA TAREA DE TRANSMITIR LA FE»

Nos dice el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica que el "EL COMIENZO (cf. Lc. 3,23) DE LA VIDA PÚBLICA DE JESÚS ES SU BAUTISMO por Juan en el Jordán (cf. Hch. 1,22). Juan proclamaba 'un bautismo de conversión para el perdón de los pecados' (Lc. 3, 3). Una multitud de pecadores, publicanos y soldados (cf. Lc. 3,10-14), fariseos y saduceos (cf. Mt. 3,7) y prostitutas (cf. Mt. 21,32) viene a hacerse bautizar por él. 'Entonces aparece Jesús'. El Bautista duda. Jesús insiste y recibe el bautismo. Entonces EL ESPÍRITU SANTO, EN FORMA DE PALOMA, VIENE SOBRE JESÚS, y la voz del cielo proclama que él es 'mi Hijo amado' (Mt. 3,13-17). ES LA MANIFESTACIÓN ('Epifanía') DE JESÚS COMO MESÍAS DE ISRAEL E HIJO DE DIOS" (535).

Pero, "el bautismo de Jesús es, por su parte, LA ACEPTACIÓN Y LA INAUGURACIÓN DE SU MISIÓN DE SIERVO DOLIENTE. Se deja contar entre los pecadores (cf. Is. 53,12); es ya 'el Cordero de Dios que quita el pecado del mundo' (Jn. 1,29); anticipa ya el 'bautismo' de su muerte sangrienta (cf. Mc. 10,38; Lc. 12,50). Viene ya a 'cumplir toda justicia' (Mt. 3,15), es decir, *se somete enteramente a la voluntad de su Padre: por amor acepta el bautismo de muerte para la remisión de nuestros pecados* (cf. Mt. 26, 39). A esta aceptación *responde la voz del Padre que pone toda su complacencia en su Hijo* (cf. Lc. 3, 22; Is. 42,1). El Espíritu que Jesús posee en plenitud desde su concepción viene a 'POSARSE' SOBRE ÉL (Jn. 1,32-33; cf. Is. 11,2). De él manará este Espíritu para toda la humanidad. En su bautismo, 'SE ABRIERON LOS CIELOS' (Mt. 3,16) que el pecado de Adán había cerrado; y LAS AGUAS FUERON SANTIFICADAS por el descenso de Jesús y del Espíritu como preludio de la nueva creación" (536).

Así, "POR EL BAUTISMO, EL CRISTIANO SE ASIMILA SACRAMENTALMENTE A JESÚS que *anticipa en su bautismo su muerte y su resurrección*. debe entrar en este misterio de rebajamiento humilde y de arrepentimiento, DESCENDER AL AGUA CON JESÚS, para SUBIR CON ÉL, RENACER DEL AGUA Y DEL ESPÍRITU para convertirse, en el Hijo, en HIJO AMADO DEL PADRE y 'vivir una vida nueva' (Rm. 6,4)" (537).

De esta manera, con la fiesta del Bautismo del Señor SE CONCLUYE EL TIEMPO LITÚRGICO DE LA NAVIDAD. El Bautismo *expresa muy bien el sentido global de las festividades navideñas*, en las que el tema de LLEGAR A SER HIJOS DE DIOS GRACIAS A LA VENIDA DEL HIJO UNIGÉNITO EN NUESTRA HUMANIDAD constituye un elemento dominante. *Él se hizo hombre para que nosotros podamos llegar a ser hijos de Dios*. DIOS NACIÓ PARA QUE NOSOTROS PODAMOS RENACER. Estos conceptos aparecen continuamente en los textos litúrgicos navideños y constituyen un motivo entusiasmante de reflexión y esperanza. Pensemos en lo que escribe san Pablo a los Gálatas: "Envió Dios



a su Hijo, nacido de mujer, nacido bajo la ley, para rescatar a los que se hallaban bajo la ley, y para que recibiéramos la filiación adoptiva" (Gál. 4,4-5); o en lo que dice san Juan en el Prólogo de su Evangelio: "A todos los que la recibieron les dio poder de hacerse hijos de Dios" (Jn. 1,12). Este estupendo misterio, que constituye nuestro "SEGUNDO NACIMIENTO", el renacimiento de un ser humano de lo alto, de Dios (cf. Jn. 3,1-8), SE REALIZA Y SE RESUME EN EL SIGNO SACRAMENTAL DEL BAUTISMO.

Como lo evidencia el papa Benedicto XVI en el ángelus del domingo 10 de enero de 2010, con este sacramento el hombre SE CONVIERTE REALMENTE EN HIJO, EN HIJO DE DIOS. Desde ese momento *el fin de su existencia consiste en alcanzar de manera libre y consciente aquello que desde el inicio era y es el destino del hombre*. "CONVIÉRTETE EN LO QUE ERES", constituye EL PRINCIPIO EDUCATIVO BÁSICO DE LA PERSONA HUMANA REDIMIDA POR LA GRACIA. Este principio tiene muchas *analogías con el crecimiento humano*, en el que la relación de los padres con los hijos pasa, a través de alejamientos y crisis, de la dependencia total a la conciencia de ser hijo, al agradecimiento por el don de la vida recibida, y a la madurez y la capacidad de dar la vida. Engendrado por el Bautismo a una nueva vida, también el cristiano comienza su camino de crecimiento en la fe que lo llevará a INVOCAR CONSCIENTEMENTE A DIOS COMO "ABBÁ - PADRE", a dirigirse a él con gratitud y a vivir la alegría de ser su hijo.

DEL BAUTISMO DERIVA TAMBIÉN UN MODELO DE SOCIEDAD: LA DE LOS HERMANOS. La fraternidad no se puede establecer mediante una *ideología* y mucho menos por *decreto de un poder constituido*. NOS RECONOCEMOS HERMANOS A PARTIR DE LA HUMILDE Y PROFUNDA CONCIENCIA DEL SER HIJOS DEL ÚNICO PADRE CELESTIAL. Como cristianos, GRACIAS AL ESPÍRITU SANTO, RECIBIDO EN EL BAUTISMO, se nos ha concedido EL DON Y EL COMPROMISO DE VIVIR COMO HIJOS DE DIOS Y COMO HERMANOS, para ser como "levadura" de una humanidad nueva, solidaria y llena de paz y esperanza. En esto nos ayuda la conciencia de tener, además de un Padre en los cielos, también

UNA MADRE, LA IGLESIA, de la que LA VIRGEN MARÍA ES MODELO PERENNE.

No podemos olvidar que, como lo refiere el papa Francisco en la homilía del domingo 13 de enero de 2019, al comienzo de la celebración del Sacramento de Bautismo se les pregunta a los padres: "¿Qué quieren para sus hijos?" Y todos ellos dicen: "LA FE". Piden a la Iglesia la fe para sus hijos, y HAN RECIBIDO EL ESPÍRITU SANTO Y EL DON DE LA FE, cada uno en su propio corazón, en su propia alma. Pero ESTA FE DEBE DESARROLLARSE, DEBE CRECER. Quizás, alguno puede decir: "Sí, sí, deben estudiarla...". Sí, cuando vayan al catecismo estudiarán bien la fe, aprenderán la catequesis. Pero antes de ser estudiada, LA FE DEBE SER TRANSMITIDA, y este es un trabajo que de manera especial toca a los padres y a la familia. Es una tarea que se recibe con la celebración del Bautismo: la transmisión de la fe. Y esto se hace en casa. Porque LA FE SIEMPRE DEBE SER TRANSMITIDA "EN DIALECTO": EL DIALECTO DE LA FAMILIA, el dialecto de la casa, en la atmósfera del hogar. La tarea de unos verdaderos padres cristianos es TRANSMITIR LA FE CON EL EJEMPLO, con las palabras y con la vida de fe... Y aquí existe un consejo muy útil para el crecimiento propio, del hogar y de la educación humana y cristiana de los hijos: NO DISCUTAN NUNCA DELANTE DE LOS NIÑOS. No saben la angustia que tiene un niño cuando ve que sus padres riñen.

Finalmente, encomendamos a la Virgen María a todos los niños recién bautizados y a sus familias, y le pedimos para toda la alegría de renacer cada día "de lo alto", del amor de Dios, que nos hace sus hijos y hermanos entre nosotros.

9 de enero de 2022-El Bautismo del Señor

Con la celebración del Bautismo del Señor se da por terminado el tiempo de Navidad. El Bautismo de Jesús es como una nueva epifanía, es decir, una nueva manifestación de Dios por medio de Jesús ahora en el Jordán. "El Espíritu Santo bajó sobre él y se manifestó exteriormente en forma de paloma, y del cielo vino una voz: Tú eres mi Hijo, hoy te he dado la vida" (Lucas 3,22). La revelación del Padre se manifiesta proclamando a Jesús como su Hijo.

El Papa Francisco en una de sus catequesis lo muestra en tres puntos muy importantes para todos los que hemos sido bautizados en Cristo Jesús: "Jesús quiso recibir el bautismo predicado y administrado por Juan el Bautista en el Jordán. ¡Cuánta humildad tiene Jesús! Y al hacerlo, manifestó lo que hemos celebrado en Navidad: sumergirse en el río de la humanidad". Jesús, va con todo a lo que refiere la cuestión humana, menos en el pecado. "El Evangelio subraya que Jesús, apenas salió del agua vio rasgarse los cielos y el Espíritu que bajaba hacia él como una paloma. El Espíritu Santo desciende en plenitud sobre Jesús para darle la fortaleza de cumplir su misión". Por medio de nuestra vocación es que tenemos nuestra misión en la vida. ¿Cómo la estamos cumpliendo? "La fiesta del bautismo de Jesús invita a cada cristiano a recordar su bautismo". ¿Sabes, o recuerdas la fecha de tu bautismo?
