

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

This Wednesday, September 13th, the Church celebrates the Memorial of Saint John Chrysostom. He lived from 347-407 AD, and he was a Doctor of the Church and the bishop of Constantinople (modern day Istanbul, Turkey). Saint John was born in Antioch, Syria, and he studied both law and theology. Beginning early in life, Saint John was ascetical and punished his body with strict fasting. Extreme mortification was common among the early saints, and it frequently led to serious health problems later on. We need to acknowledge that one can live a pious life while still taking care of one's body! Saint John wanted to become a monk early in life, but his poor health prevented him from doing so. He was ordained a priest by Bishop Flavian of Antioch in 386 AD at the age of 39. Saint John was known for his great oratory skills and powerful homilies, and he was given the title of "golden-mouthed" which is "Chrysostom" in Greek. In 389 AD, he was made Bishop of Constantinople, only three years after ordination to the priesthood. Such a quick elevation to bishop would never happen that quickly today!

Within a short time after being named bishop, Saint John regretted the decision. The Byzantine imperial court was filled with intrigue and the aristocracy resented his calls for reform. The Empress Eudoxia considered many of John's sermons personal attacks on her government. It didn't help that his references to the lurid Queen Jezebel and the impious Herodias (the one who asked for Saint John the Baptist's head) were associated with the Empress. John's homilies often contained harsh criticism of the selfish wealthy class and the excesses of the Byzantine court. So, over time, he ended up angering most of the people he was preaching to. Eventually, John was exiled to a rugged part of Asia Minor (modern Turkey), and he died September 14, 407. John Chrysostom's preaching by word and example exemplifies the role of the prophet to comfort the afflicted and to afflict the comfortable. In exile John wrote the following: "Let the world be in upheaval. I hold to his promise and read his message; that is my protecting

read his message; that is my protecting wall and garrison. What message? Know that I am with you always, until the end of the world. If Christ is with me, whom shall I fear." Those are good words for us to hear as well.
