Holy Orders & Vowed Religious Life: Anyone interested in ordained or vowed religious life is invited to talk to one of the parish priests or pastoral staff members.

Ministry to the Sick: Anointing of the Sick is available upon request. The parish staff members regularly bring Eucharist to the sick upon request. Please notify the Parish Office in case of hospitalization.

Eucharistic Adoration: Would you consider an hour a week with the Lord? If you would like to spend an hour in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, call the Parish Office for the combination to the door.

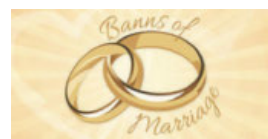

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD, MAY 29, 2022, YEAR C

EASTER REFLECTION:

This solemnity, celebrated on Sunday in many parts of the country but also on Thursday in others, once again takes on the meaning of the paschal mystery for all the faithful. In the first reading and Gospel, we hear about the journey of the risen Lord, and in the letter to the Hebrews we can clearly see the depth of Christ's sacrifice, through which he obtained our salvation. Christ goes to the Father but does not abandon his disciples; he keeps his promise to accompany them and promises the Holy Spirit will strengthen the ministry he has called them to. On this solemnity, Christ invites us to once again celebrate God's victory over fear and evil. How do today's readings and the meaning of this solemnity confront the shadows in our contemporary culture, such as fear and hatred? How can our Lord's victory overcome the presence of these shadows? I suppose these musings are my way of encouraging you to keep trying! The Mass music usually has something for everyone: something new, something old, something on the organ, something on the piano...Today, I ask you to summon your courage and sing joyfully to the God that created you!

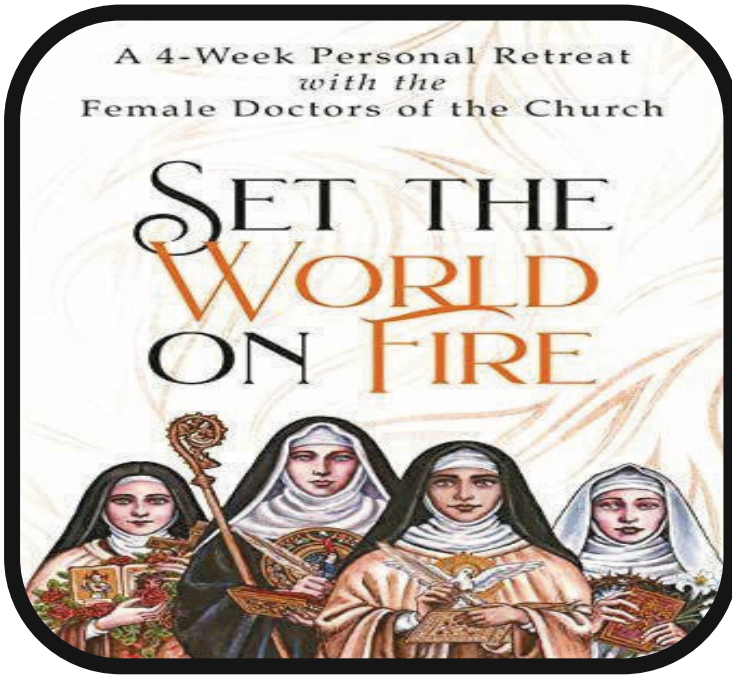

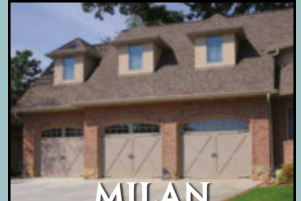

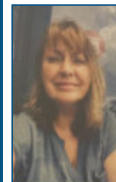
