


# ST. JOHN VIANNEY

**Holy Orders & Vowed Religious Life:** Anyone interested in ordained or vowed religious life is invited to talk to one of the parish priests or pastoral staff members.

**Ministry to the Sick:** Anointing of the Sick is available upon request. The parish staff members regularly bring Eucharist to the sick upon request. Please notify the Parish Office in case of hospitalization.

### FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, JULY 3, 2022, YEAR C

REFLECTION: When the Israelites lived in exile for centuries, their hope was focused on returning to Jerusalem, the holy city, and especially to the Temple, the site of their spiritual roots. As the years went by, the hope of their return was transformed into maintaining their identity as Israelites wherever they lived. In today's readings, we sense their longing for Jerusalem in Isaiah's reading and the affirmation of their cultural identity in Saint Paul's, who also adds a new spiritual dimension: Christ, the Lord. Paul carries on his own body the marks of the Lord, superior to circumcision, for, by the mercy of God, Paul has understood and accepted suffering as grace. What is our hope? What are our future projects? Are we willing to discern them in the light of the Gospel texts? Just as Jesus sent his disciples to preach good news, he also sends us with our family members to sow the seeds of the good news in our neighborhoods. Source: liturgy.com



# Longing for Prophets

BY SHIRLEY KAUFMAN Not for their ice-pick eyes, their weeping willow hair, and their clenched fists beating at heaven. Not for their warnings, predictions of doom. But what they promised. I don't care if their beards are mildewed, and the ladders are broken. Let them go on picking the wormy fruit. Let the one with the yoke around his neck climb out of the cistern. Let them come down from the heights in their radiant despair like the Sankei Juko dancers descending on ropes, down from these hills to the earth of their first existence. Let them follow the track we've cut on the sides of mountains into the desert, and stumble again through the great rift, littered with bones and the walls of cities. Let them sift through the ashes with their burned hands. Let them tell us what will come after.

At times in our country, our spirit of American freedom devolves into a rebellious impulse to disavow higher authority and mistrust those who strive to lead us; yet deep down, we all desire to cling to some sort of truth from someone's mouth. Thus even the radical nonconformist is the faithful disciple of some thinker or pundit.

In today's Gospel, we see the efficacy of the 72 disciples when they preach the coming of God's Kingdom to people hungering for something to satisfy their spiritual desires. Because of the power and the beauty of the Good News and the joy and authenticity with which a disciple presents it, people will embrace it in droves. But Jesus warns the disciples at the end of the passage not to get caught up in their own success in ministry but in the eternal goodness they have received and want to share.

In her poem, Kaufman points to a message similar to that of Jesus: people want prophets for the hope they offer of a better future on earth and especially in heaven. Their predictions of doom and their eccentric actions may indeed play a pivotal part in their mission, but their foresight of hope truly draws people. May we be prophets who share our faith through our joyful hope we witness to others every day.

I hope that you have a great holiday weekend. Mass will be celebrated in the front of the church on Monday, July 4, at 9:00, and the Parish Office Center will be closed for the holiday. We will reopen on

Tuesday morning at 8:30. Be careful and stay safe this weekend!

The Catholic Faith, Family and Fun Festival, the FEST, will take place on Sunday, August 7, at the Center for Pastoral Leadership. The theme this year is "Homecoming" as we celebrate the return of the FEST to the Borromeo Campus after a two year absence. A representative of the FEST is here this weekend to encourage you to save the date and plan to attend next month. A FEST display table is in the church gathering space with information on the schedule of events for this year's event.

There is also a table in the gathering space with information about our parish festival which will take place next weekend, July 8, 9, & 10. Please stop by and let us know if you are able to volunteer at one or more of the booths or activities. We definitely still need help and anything you can do to help will be greatly appreciated by me and other members of the staff. Thank you to the members of the Festival Core Committee for the work they have done the past few months and thanks to the day-time crew, the evening crew and the Saturday crew for all the help with set-up. Some of those days were very hot days and I am sure it was not easy working here for so many hours. Please also keep in your prayers the roofers from Runyon for the hard work they continue to do daily to replace our roofs. I keep them in my daily prayers, especially on those very hot days when they are up on the roof. I can

only imagine how hot it must be up there. I heard that one day the temperature gauge said 150 degrees! God bless those dedicated and hard working men from Runyon!

Progress continues to be made on the roof project. The crane was here last Monday and returned the roof air conditioners to their proper places which were prepared by the roofers for their return. I am hoping that by the time you are reading this, the air conditioners will be connected and working again. One of the two roof air conditioners for the church is not working to capacity as we wait for a part that has been on back order. To some people I know that is good news since some reported last year that it was too cold in the church. As I said last year, the coldest seats in the church are the ones that are in the back of the church, right below the vents which blow out the cool air for the rest of the church. When the units are working to capacity, remember if you want to avoid the cooler seats, move up to the front of the church. Those are also the seats which are closest to the speakers and are best suited for those who have a hard time hearing. One of the things we will purchase soon from the Rays of Mercy campaign funds is a device which will help the hearingimpaired to hear better in the church. Watch the bulletin for more information in the fall. You can see on the next page that we could use additional donations or pledges to help us reach our campaign goal. Please do what you can to help us and know that we appreciate all that you give and do for the parish.

We will be blessing bikes of all types today, on Sunday, July 3, after the 10:30 Mass in the parking lot. Prizes will be awarded to the riders of the bikes with the most patriotic decorations for Independence Day. I mentioned last year that this tradition was something my siblings and I looked forward to each year at Shore Acres Park on 151st Street in Cleveland each 4th of July weekend. 




