PASTOR'S PAGE

Dear Parishioners.

We have a brief bulletin this week since I have been out of town since Monday and since late July tends to be a slower time at the parish. Many people are on vacation now and many people need a break from parish activities after a busy few weeks with the Summer Festival.

The Summer Festival went very well as I mentioned in last week's bulletin. A lot of friends and parishioners were here for the three days and God blessed us with great weather. I placed a short survey in the bulletin last weekend to request some feedback from you regarding what you liked and where you saw the need for some improvement. I will have additional copies of the survey in the John Paul II Room next weekend when we serve coffee and donuts. Please take a few moments then to give us some feedback and let us know if you wish to be considered to serve on the Festival Core Committee next year and why. We have a few open spaces on the core committee since some individuals will be retiring after many years of service. Again, I wish to thank floor of the new church before we placed the floor everyone for their help and support of this year's festival. It was great to get back to having a more traditional one after the two years of a smaller festival due to COVID. I think many people appreciated the opportunity to come together for some good old fashioned summer fun. You helped to make that happen and that was priceless for people who were eager to finally be free and outdoors and with a crowd of family and friends!

The festival was great fun and also very profitable as a fundraiser. It will take weeks before we pay all the bills associated with this festival and actually know our net profit. However, we know at this point that we collected \$238,000 in gross sales (before any expenses have been deducted). This \$238,000 in gross sales included \$86,000 in raffle ticket sales, \$16,000 in basket raffle sales, \$27,000 at the Food Pavilion and an additional \$7,000 at Fast Food, \$15,000 in Festival Games. \$18,000 in the Monte Carlo, and \$18,000 in beer sales. I will share more information in the coming weeks about the festival. Until then, let us all continue to thank the Lord for his blessings on all that we do at this parish and for keeping us safe and well.

Remember that 2022-2023 RCIA process will begin on Wednesday, August 31. Please call one of the parish priests if you or someone you

know is thinking about becoming a member of the Catholic Church. Parents of our ninth graders are reminded to schedule soon the enrollment interview for their son or daughter who wishes to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the spring. The enrollment interview needs to take place prior to the Confirmation Orientation session which will take place for candidates and their parents on Sunday, August 28. The members of the parish "50+ Club" are asked to save the date of Thursday, August 11, 6:00 pm, to attend the pot-luck dinner in the Social Center and to participate in a discussion of how and when to resume the activities members would like to do in the coming year.

Beginning today, and continuing to Sunday, July 31, you are invited to sign your name on a shingle which will be placed on the roof of the Parish Office Center after August 1. In addition, you can make a donation if you wish to do so. We did something similar in the spring of 2002 when we invited you to write your name on the concrete tiles. That was your chance to be part of the church's foundation and now you have a chance to "help us raise the roof!" Progress continues to be made on the project and almost everything should be done before Bishop Malesic joins us for a Mass and a roof blessing on Saturday, October 1. The Finance Council will meet on Monday evening to approve the parish and school budgets for the fiscal year which began on July 1, and to discuss ways we can raise some additional funds to reach the goal we set for the Rays of Mercy Campaign. On the following Monday evening, August 1, at 8:00 pm, Katie Cooper, our Music Director, has planned a Sunset Taize Prayer Service at the park at the end of Reynolds Road. We will gather, weather permitting, at the park to sing and praise the Lord with our neighbors and friends as we watch the sun slowly set in the west on a beautiful summer evening, a precious gift from the Lord, the giver of all good things! Taize prayer is filled with song, scripture and silent meditation. This ecumenical form of prayer is modeled on the style as practiced in the Taize Community in France. Those who attend regularly find a profound peace and tranquility in this style of prayer. If you are like me, you could probably use some peace and tranquility these days. Hope to see you there. 
