



Bishop Zubik Appoints Fr. Brendan Dawson Pastor of Saint Jude Parish

Father Dawson was ordained a priest June 29, 2019 at St. Paul Cathedral. He grew up in West Deer Township in Northern Allegheny County. For the last three years he has been a parochial vicar at Holy Spirit Parish in Newcastle, PA.

Last week's wonderful announcement that we have a young, energetic, and happy new pastor shows that our parish family is about to encounter another stage of parish life that will be transformative and even more abundant!



I believe it will be all of that and more. I invited Father Brendan (as he likes to be called) to meet with me very soon. He is anxious to meet with the entire staff soon as well. When you meet him in person, you will see for yourself his joy and sincerity; two of the finest qualities of a good priest and pastor of his flock.

Based on your current working relationship with him, I trust that you can appreciate this new dimension of your priestly fraternity with him.

To further demonstrate the very real and important union between yourself as Pastor and myself as Diocesan Bishop, I look forward to coming to the parish for your installation.

Ladies of Charity Meeting






