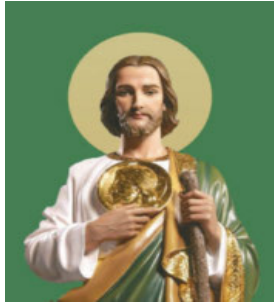

Bishop Zubik Appoints Fr. Brendan Dawson Pastor of Saint Jude Parish

Bishop Zubik has appointed Father Brendan Dawson pastor of Saint Jude Parish. Father Dawson's appointment will be effective on September 12, 2022. Father Dawson was ordained a priest June 29, 2019 at St. Paul Cathedral. He grew up in West Deer Township in Northern Allegheny County. For the last three years he has been a parochial vicar at Holy Spirit Parish in Newcastle, PA.



Last week's wonderful announcement that we have a young, energetic, and happy new pastor shows that our parish family is about to encounter another stage of parish life that will be transformative and even more abundant!

I believe it will be all of that and more. I invited Father Brendan (as he likes to be called) to meet with me very soon. He is anxious to meet with the entire staff soon as well. When you meet him in person, you will see for yourself his joy and sincerity; two of the finest qualities of a good priest and pastor of his flock.

Dear Father Dawson:

One of the dreams of most diocesan priests is to become a pastor of a parish. To be given such an important role in the Church is an act of trust between the diocesan bishop and his priests. To shepherd a parish involves being pastor to the flock entrusted to his care and at the same time being responsible for the administration of any, and all, parish entities as noted.

It is with great joy that I appoint you Pastor of Saint Jude Parish, Morningside/Shadyside/Stanton Heights, effective Monday, September 12, 2022, for a term of six (6) years according to Canon 523 of the *Code of Canon Law*. At the same time, I relieve you of your responsibilities as Parochial Vicar at Holy Spirit Parish, Lawrence County.

As you begin this important new page of your priestly ministry, without question, you have my trust as you embrace the charge to shepherd the faith community of Saint Jude Parish. As you assume these new responsibilities and as a young pastor, it is imperative that you have a mentor who will assist you in the learning curve of becoming a pastor. I have asked Father Joseph R. McCaffrey to assist you as mentor. He is thrilled to do so. Based on your current working relationship with him, I trust that you can appreciate this new dimension of your priestly fraternity with him.

To further demonstrate the very real and important union between yourself as Pastor and myself as Diocesan Bishop, I look forward to coming to the parish for your installation.

As I express my gratitude to you for taking on this new charge, I promise you my prayerful support as well as my genuine affection.
