



Merry Christmas! Unlike the stores, we will celebrate Christmas until January 9th!

There are many thanks to be given this Christmas. Thanks to all the parishioners who remembered the Clergy Team and staff with your various Christmas greetings. Thanks too to all the folks who helped to decorate our churches for the season. Thanks too for all the liturgical ministers who made the Christmas Liturgies happen. It is all appreciated. May the New-Born Savior bless you all!

Another round of thanks to all of you for your generosity to the "Community Charities" envelope for the last third of the year. I signed a check the other week payable to the North Hills Community Outreach for \$7,265.00! Your generosity is overwhelming! Be reminded that the next three envelopes are destined for our own St. Vincent de Paul Society and the good work they do in our midst. I ask for your continued generosity to these community givebacks.

Truly, I love when a church is filled with people. I wish it were like that all the time. Not only are our buildings gorgeous year -round, they are always better looking for the Christmas Season. 
Sanctuary Candles

BAPTISM: Prior registration is necessary. A formation session for parents is also required. All paperwork needs to be on hand prior to scheduling. Call Carol at ext. 380.

RECONCILIATION: See the front cover page for times in our grouping. Other times are available by appointment.

FIRST COMMUNION: First Holy Communion is usually celebrated in the Spring. Children candidates are expected to be enrolled in the parish faith formation program. Contact Louis at ext. 413 for details and registration.

HOME BOUND: Upon request, Holy Communion can be brought to the home by the Priest, Deacon, or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion. Contact Elaine at ext. 419.

CONFIRMATION: The parish celebrates confirmation in the fall of 9th Grade. Contact ext. 415 for details and registration. Any adult (over 18) should contact Louis at ext. 413 for details and registration.

MARRIAGE: Potential couples wishing to be married in the Catholic Church must contact the Priest or Deacon at least six months before the desired date. No date can be guaranteed until the couple has met with one of the parish clergy team. Please start with contacting the Priest or Deacon you wish to witness your marriage.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK: This sacrament is administered by a Priest and is preferred when the recipient is aware of its healing power. Communal Anointing of the Sick Masses are offered during the year - in the fall and in the spring in one of our churches.




