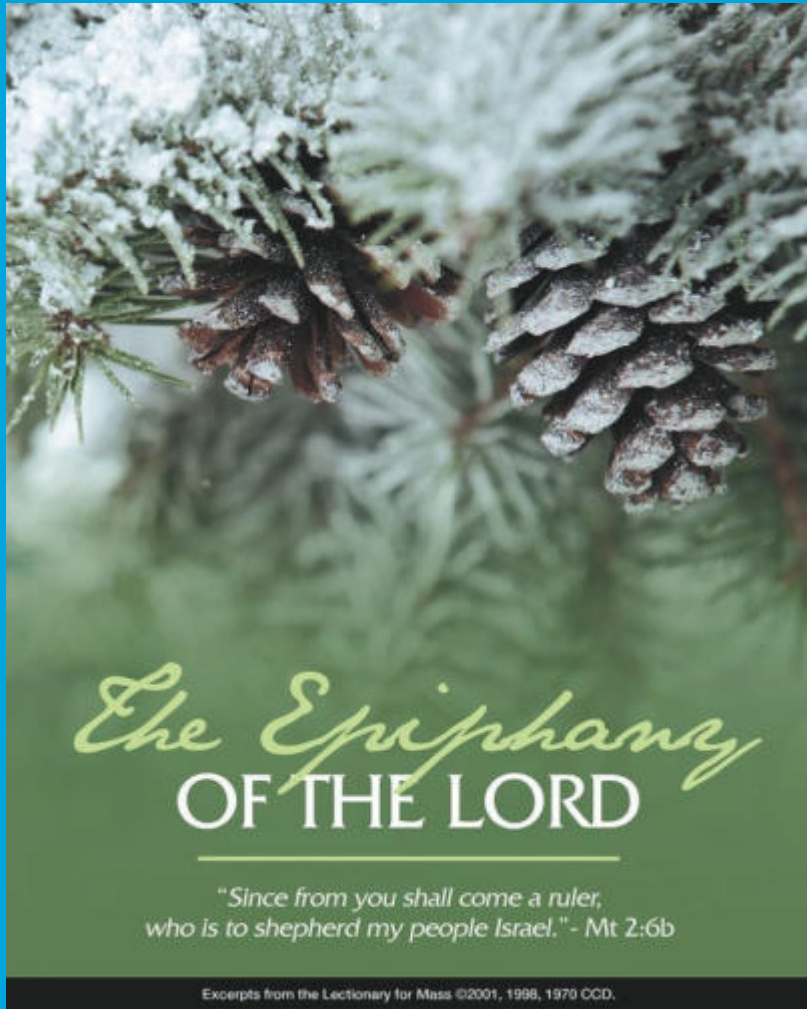

From the Desk of the Pastor

Earlier last month (last year!) I had put some thoughts together for this column realizing it involved an early deadline. However, they are lost “in the cloud” of my document storage! Therefore, I KNOW I’m forgetting to include something important in this week’s column. For that I am sorry.

While the new year is but hours old, I take this opportunity on behalf of the Clergy Team and Staff to wish you a Blessed New Year! As I learned many years ago: May the BEST days of the past year be the WORST days of the year ahead! And let’s hope there are many better days ahead in 2022!

On the docket for January 12-14th is an important work detail. I have contracted with Hosanna Industries to assist us with the renovation work at the old SA Convent to become our central office. I can share that behind the scenes, there were some major hurdles to get this project moving forward. However, they have been jumped and we can begin parts of it. Mainly that will involve painting walls, ripping up carpet, and refinishing some floors. Once our building permit is issued, we can construct the three walls necessary and other building aspects. The work detail will meet from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm those three days. The project needs about 10 volunteers each day. I think I can arrange for some evening hours, if that works better for you. Please lend a hand. The more hands we have, the easier (and quicker) the work!

Speaking of work, next Sunday marks the end of the Christmas Season as we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Each of our churches will need help disassembling the Christmas Decorations. Most of the work will begin after the last Sunday Mass. If you’d like to help, let Anna Trovato know!

During recent Staff and Advisory Council (Parish Pastoral and Finance) meetings, we have been engaged in some important work. The most important thing has been chartering our work. This process from “Good Leaders, Good Shepherds” becomes the *Robert’s Rules of Order for our meetings*. I will work on publishing on the website the Sponsorship Letter from me to them to initiate the process. I will also see to the publishing of our charters. Among the highlights planned for the coming year are understanding what a parish is, the various roles (pastor, staff, councils) involved in a parish, and then developing a five-year pastoral plan for the parish. There are also some important benchmarks to be met. Stay tuned for what those are and how you can be involved. It’s an exciting time for the parish.

And before I forget, Happy Anniversary! Remember that Tuesday marks the one-year anniversary of our founding! As Priests often say to each other: *Ad multos annos – to many more years! May St. Matthew continue to intercede for us!*

Since they are still in the process of coming back online, the number of food offerings are smaller than in the past. However, they will continue to grow. And it's a great option for shopping without physical contact.

Before discontinuing business in 2015, Market Day shipped all food orders to the church/school once a month and the families would pick-up their items at the church/school. Under the new process: Just place your order online and they will ship directly to you. Your orders will arrive via FedEx using an eco-friendly cooler with dry ice. Orders will ship within 1 to 2 days of being placed and will be packed to remain frozen for up to 8 hours after they arrive at your front door. All orders of \$119 or over receive free shipping. SMP receives a portion of all sales which will benefit our parish each month. Order online at www.marketday.com. When you register as a customer, under "Select An Organization" type in "St. Matthew Parish", and select it when it asks. Proceeds will benefit all four of our churches.

PARISH LIFE

BAPTISM: Prior registration is necessary. A formation session for parents is also required. All paperwork needs to be on hand prior to scheduling. Call Carol at ext. 380.

RECONCILIATION: See the front cover page for times in our grouping. Other times are available by appointment.

FIRST COMMUNION: First Holy Communion is usually celebrated in the Spring. Children candidates are expected to be enrolled in the parish faith formation program. Contact Louis at ext. 413 for details and registration.

HOME BOUND: Upon request, Holy Communion can be brought to the home by the Priest, Deacon, or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion. Contact Elaine at ext. 419.

CONFIRMATION: The parish celebrates confirmation in the fall of 9th Grade. Contact ext. 415 for details and registration. Any adult (over 18) should contact Louis at ext. 413 for details and registration.

MARRIAGE: Potential couples wishing to be married in the Catholic Church must contact the Priest or Deacon at least six months before the desired date. No date can be guaranteed until the couple has met with one of the parish clergy team. Please start with contacting the Priest or Deacon you wish to witness your marriage.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK: This sacrament is administered by a Priest and is preferred when the recipient is aware of its healing power. Communal Anointing of the Sick Masses are offered during the year - in the fall and in the spring in one of our churches.

RCIA: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is open to any adult interested in becoming a Roman Catholic Christian through a program of formation and prayer. Call Louis at ext. 413 for details and registration.

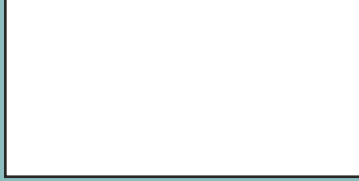
