

#### From the Desk of the Pastor

You know, volunteers are always needed around the parish. Where do YOUR interests lie? I can offer you a few thoughts. First, today is "un-decorating day" at the parish. Each of the churches will be dismantling the Christmas decorations. Most are doing so following the last Mass. If you have a moment today, lend a hand!

Second, I am launching an altar server campaign! We need all kinds of servers. We need youth to help at the Sunday and later Holy Day Masses. I am not against adult servers on the weekends. We can use some adults to help with weekday Masses, Funeral Masses, and the early Holy Day Masses. For any server, my hope would be that volunteering is the most important concern and then which location is secondary. You're coming to Mass, why not serve, right? Sign up through the application found in today's bulletin!

Third, I have to publicly confess that I have a black thumb! I enjoy the beauty of gardening, though, I can heartily agree to something I recently heard someone say: "Plants come to my house to die!" Guilty as charged! I'd like to get some gardeners together for our campuses. I know we have a few folks already involved with this ministry. However, a few more hands would make for easier and quicker work. Even some bulk purchasing might be possible. I'll be planning a meeting soon! I hope you'll attend and offer your talent to the Lord.

Another gardening need is the care of five trees along Howard Street in Millvale. The parish has adopted those trees and now we are to care for them! Notice I said "we" not "me"! (See my previous comment!) If there are some creative arborists out there, the parish needs you! I think it's more caring for the beds around them than the trees themselves. Details of what is necessary are available.

On the docket for January 12-14th is an important work detail. I have contracted with Hosanna Industries to assist us with the renovation work at the old SA Convent to become our central office. I can share that behind the scenes, there were some major hurdles to get this project moving forward. However, they have been jumped and we can begin parts of it. Mainly that will involve painting walls, ripping up carpet, and refinishing some floors. Once our building permit is issued, we can construct the three walls necessary and other building aspects. The work detail will meet from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm those three days. The project needs about 10 volunteers each day. I think I can arrange for some evening hours, if that works better for you. Please lend a hand. The more hands we have, the easier (and quicker) the work!

Back on December 7th, I received a letter from Sr. Josephine of the Little Sisters of the Poor. It was a thank you for the \$8,915.65 that was collected from the parish! She said it was from the recent collection. I don't know if that's just the second weekend or a grand total. Whichever it is, you folks rock, as they say! Your generosity to the Little Sisters is overwhelming and greatly appreciated by them and the elderly poor they serve!

### **COVID** update from Bishop Zubik

(Editor's note: The following was received late on Friday, December 31, 2021. It is included here in brief form. The full version is found on the parish's website and Facebook page.)

The celebration of the Holy Mass, where we gather to worship God and receive Holy Communion, is the heart of our Catholic faith. [Therefore we remind] everyone of the current diocesan safety protocols:

- The obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Day Mass in person was restored effective Sunday, August 15, 2021.
- The practices of extending the Sign of Peace at Mass and the distribution of the Precious Blood are suspended until further notice.
- Mask-wearing is urgently encouraged for all attending Mass regardless of vaccination status.
- All liturgical ministers must continue to wear masks at all times except when speaking.
- All greeters and ushers must wear masks while welcoming parishioners, should maintain social-distancing, and should refrain from hand-shaking with fellow parishioners.


