



From the Desk of the Pastor

There are a few things to bring to your attention. Let me share them with you.

Bishop Zubik released some new COVID guidelines on December 31, 2021, that appeared in last week's bulletin. On January 7, 2022, he further added to the guidelines. "The presentation of the gifts is suspended until further notice. ... It is strongly recommended that any parish events outside of Holy Mass are to either be canceled, rescheduled, or be held virtually. ... Livestream Mass options are to continue...." Speaking of which, while ours is done via Facebook Live, all viewers need to do is navigate to the parish website. When it goes live it will go live there. In addition, our viewership has increased. A few extra cameramen (or women!) would be VERY helpful! As for non-Mass events, like the Adoration Chapel, Rosaries, Novenas, and the like, I have been suggesting if people are comfortable in meeting, they can do so as long as people are masked, physically distanced, and spaces are sanitized afterward.

I have been remiss in adding my congratulations to our new Auxiliary Bishop, the Most Reverend Mark A. Eckman, D.D. When I was in the Worship Office, I worked closely with then Fr. Eckman when a brother Priest died. I always found him very pleasant. I wish him many years of service to the Church as a part of the College of Bishops. I do hope you saw the SMP congratulatory ad in *The Pittsburgh Catholic Magazine*.

Our new full time Maintenance man, Vincent Watkins, has begun his ministry with us. He has moved from Everett, PA to be with us. (Everett is just west of Breezewood.) He comes with a background in two interesting disciplines: aviation and theology! Please make him feel welcome when you see him.

I am still working on hiring a youth minister. There was a promising candidate that somehow got away from us. It was very strange. Perhaps it was for the best. Let's hope that we can find the right fit for us!

When parishioners received their envelopes the other week, there were lots of questions about the envelope entitled "Parish Appeal". That takes a bit of explaining. The pastors/administrators long wished that Bishop Zubik would restructure both the Parish Share Program and how School Subsidies were decided. Well, one day, he did! It was passed down to us as happening in a matter of months. The Parish Share Program would be rebranded as the "Parish Appeal" and the way subsidies were decided moved from a legacy format to an across-the-board tax. My brothers were not pleased, to say the least. He called a special meeting of the pastors/administrators to discuss the concerns. After that meeting, he decided to put off the rebranding campaign for one year in order to be able to make that conversion. Meanwhile, SMP had already been in contact with our envelope provider and made the switch! So, while the envelope might say "Parish Appeal" it is designated to fulfill our goal of the 2022 Parish Share Program. Therefore, the current 2021 Parish Share Campaign comes to an end on January 31, 2022. The 2022 Parish Appeal/Share Campaign will begin on February 1, 2022 and will end on December 31, 2022. The 2023 Parish Appeal Campaign will run the calendar year. Recall that any money collected above our assessment remains with us tax-free, at least for one more year. Therefore, I encourage your continued generosity to the Parish Appeal/Share Campaign.


<u>SMP Men's Club</u> coffee/donut social that was scheduled for TODAY, January 16, has been Cancelled.

BAPTISM: Prior registration is necessary. A formation session for parents is also required. All paperwork needs to be on hand prior to scheduling. Call Carol at ext. 380.

FIRST COMMUNION: First Holy Communion is usually celebrated in the Spring. Children candidates are expected to be enrolled in the parish faith formation program. Contact Louis at ext. 413 for details and registration.

HOME BOUND: Upon request, Holy Communion can be brought to the home by the Priest, Deacon, or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion. Contact Elaine at ext. 419.


