



From the Desk of the Pastor

The week of January 11th brought a lot of good things to SMP. Let me share!

The first is the hiring of a Coordinator of Youth Ministry! And there was great rejoicing! Join me in welcoming to the staff Morgan Hall! She hails from Carlisle, PA in the Diocese of Harrisburg. She's a recent graduate of Franciscan University. She has a great passion for youth ministry as it touched her life and led her to where she is today. In the modern world, hiring can't be as quick as I would like. There are righteous concerns regarding the Safe Environment Policy and such. Therefore, her anticipated start date is February 7. I will make sure she makes the rounds to introduce herself to you at the Sunday Masses. I know she will bring her own God-given gifts and talents to the parish and program! Welcome, Morgan!

That same week saw the painting at the new central offices of SMP. I am forever indebted to Hosanna Industries for their assistance to us in this endeavor. Within three days, all the carpeting was removed as well as every single room and hallway painted! On the first day, they brought in a ton of volunteers who hit an absolute home run. I would have to add that the small core of SMP parishioners and staff who assisted should receive some kudos as well! Personally, I used some muscles I haven't used in quite a while! There is still the need to have the building permit issued so that the three walls can be constructed as well as the ADA bathroom to be built on the first floor. Once that's complete, the wood floors can be refinished. At that point, it's figuring out when to make the move. A while back, I had asked our regional Vicar, Fr. John Gizler to come out for Mass and a blessing of the building. I would also anticipate an open house at that time. Stay tuned for more details.

There were also good staff and Advisory Council meetings. The professional development portion of both meetings had to do with an introduction to Fr. James Coriden's book, *The Parish in Catholic Tradition*. In a concluding section, Fr. Coriden offers his thoughts on four types of parishioners. He says they are as follows: nuclear, modal, marginal, and lapsed. The nuclear are the 20% of parishioners who do 80% of the work, either physically or financially or both. The modal are those who just come to church with little additional involvement. The marginal are, in my own words, the "Snowmen and Easter Bunnies" or the "Ch-Easters" who come for those two major holidays and perhaps very little else. Finally, the lapsed are those who never come to church, yet still consider themselves part of the parish.

While Fr. Coriden's comments were raised in the context of what it means to be a parish, it does beg us to question how do we minister to these four groups of parishioners? We are on this journey together. How do we better serve all four groups of parishioners? There's lots more to come on this and other salient topics!



BAPTISM: Prior registration is necessary. A formation session for parents is also required. All paperwork needs to be on hand prior to scheduling. Call Carol at ext. 380.

RECONCILIATION: See the front cover page for times in our grouping. Other times are available by appointment.

FIRST COMMUNION: First Holy Communion is usually celebrated in the Spring. Children candidates are expected to be enrolled in the parish faith formation program. Contact Louis at ext. 413 for details and registration.

HOME BOUND: Upon request, Holy Communion can be brought to the home by the Priest, Deacon, or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion. Contact Elaine at ext. 419.


