

This checklist, approved by Bishop Persico, is for those seeking employment in the Diocese of Erie. "WHAT IS EXPECTED OF A PRACTICING CATHOLIC" is a good reflection for all of us in light of today's Gospel — Luke 9:51-62 — emphasizing hospitality and discipleship. "A practicing Catholic is a person who is in good standing with the Church and lives in accord with the teachings of Christ and the Church. The following list provides essential

- He/she participates in the sacraments of the Church is fully initiated, i.e. has been baptized, confirmed and admitted to Holy Communion; participates in Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation; celebrates the Sacrament of Penance as needed, but not infrequently.
- He/she is a registered member of a Catholic parish and supports the parish with time, talent and treasure, according to his/her ability.
- If married, he/she is in a marriage in accord with the laws of the Church and is committed to raising children in the practice of the faith;
- If not married, he/she is living a life of conformity with single state;
- He/she is in agreement with and willing to impart the teaching of the Catholic Church as taught by the Church's magisterium;
- He/she will lead by example, encourage students to learn and practice the faith by word and example.
- He/she lives a life free of scandal, and is not bound by any ecclesiastical penalty."


