FATHER BRIAN'S DESK

On Friday of this coming week, March 19, we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Chaste Spouse of the Virgin Mary, a major feast day for Roman Catholics which most often falls during the season of Lent. As mentioned several weeks ago, this year's feast takes on special significance since we are in a special year dedicated to St. Joseph. We will celebrate three special days in his honor; a type of Triduum to request his powerful intercession. This will be held from March 17-19. Each evening Holy Mass will be celebrated at 7 p.m. preceded by a Holy Hour at 6 p.m. The Prayers of the Cloak of St. Joseph will be prayed along with the Litany of St. Joseph. Following Holy Mass each evening, blessed oil which will burn in each of our Churches in honor of St. Joseph before his sacred image, will be used to anoint those who wish to ask him for his special blessing and protection.



The prayers of the "Cloak of St. Joseph," are normally prayed for 30 days. They recall to mind the Cloak that St. Joseph wore which is believed to be in Rome and which in pious belief he used to wrap the Infant Jesus to protect him from the cold. It is therefore a prayerful symbol of St. Joseph's fatherly protection. We actually have a relic of the clothing of St. Joseph at our parish with papers authenticating it, so that it is worthy of veneration. It will be on display at both of our churches on the night of our divine services.

Please see the liturgical schedule for details in this bulletin.

Also, on Wednesday evening, the evening in which we celebrate the first night of our devotions to St. Joseph, the Mass will be a Lenten "station," for the diocese. There is an ancient practice in Rome going back to the fourth century, still preserved today, and in particular by the English speaking priests, seminarians, religious and pilgrims, in addition to the Diocese of Rome, in which the faithful gather in the day, early morning or the evening, for a special Lenten Mass, at the tomb of martyrs or other special churches in Rome. The Litany of the Saints is chanted to invoke their intercession during the penitential season of Lent. It is recommended in the Roman Missal that is used at this time, that special "station churches" are appointed in each diocese for such celebrations in Lent imitating that which is done in city of Rome, especially in shrines and special churches. Our parish has been asked to participate this year, and so diocesan pilgrims may be attending along with our parishioners on Wednesday evening, March 17, at 6 p.m.

Finally, in last week's bulletin you read a welcoming article on our new Director of Youth, Young Adult and Digital Media, Joni Mulvaney. As Pastor of the Parish, this position, I believe, is of special importance for our parish as we hand on the faith to our young people with energy, truth and vigor, and as well, engage in many new ways of evangelizing through the media. Welcome, Joni! We look forward to cooperating with you as we joyfully live and share our Roman Catholic faith!





Lenten Regulations



1. **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of fast and abstinence. The **Fridays of Lent** are days of abstinence in the United States.

2. The obligation of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) begins at age 14. The law of fasting (limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals) obliges all between the ages of 18-59. No one should consider this obligation lightly.

3. Those individuals who have a medical condition in which fasting may be considered harmful are not obliged to fast, but should perform some other act of penance or charity.

4. Pastors and parents are asked that minors, though not bound by the law of fast and abstinence, are educated in the authentic sense of penance and encouraged to do acts of penance suitable to their age.

5. Notable during this Lenten season is that the Solemnity of Saint Joseph falls on a Friday. Because of this, **there is not an obligation to abstain from meat on Friday, March 19, 2021**, the Solemnity of Saint Joseph, according to the norm of canon 1251.

6. All members of the Christian Faithful are encouraged to do acts of penance and charity during the Lenten season beyond what is prescribed by the law.

7. As a general rule, a request for dispensation from the obligation of abstinence on Fridays of Lent will not be considered unless some serious reason is present. The attendance at social events, banquets, wedding rehearsals or receptions, or funeral wakes are not considered sufficient reason to request dispensation



As approved by the combined Parish Finance Councils of Our Lady of Grace and St Bernard Parishes, now St Michael the Archangel, I am pleased to share this 2019-2020 Annual Financial Report for our two parishes and two schools, as required by the Diocese of Pittsburgh. I hope you will take a moment to review and reflect on this important information.

Please note, these reports are through June 30, 2020, prior to the merger going into effect July 1 and the schools joining with others to form the regional school, Ave Maria.

I want to begin by sincerely thanking each of you for welcoming me to the parish and for your continued prayers and support as we develop and grow as a new parish. I am pleased to say prior to the merger, our parish staffs worked hard to come together and combine work activities which resulted in substantial savings in the 2019-2020 year and on-going for St Michael the Archangel. As well, our many ministries that our parishes support, also continue to work together to ensure we are meeting the many needs of our parishioners.

Enclosed are the combined annual operating results for the two parishes and schools. Combined income, exclusive of one-time special sources, increased, despite the pandemic, from \$2.525 million to \$2.695 million. Combined expense declined from \$2.182 million to \$2.085 million. The parishes experienced a combined surplus, before school subsidy and special income, of \$609,868 compared to \$343,963 in 2018-29. After school subsidy expense, special income and excess Parish Share as of June 30th, the combined 2019-20 surplus totals \$340,914 as compared to a deficit of \$418,874 in 2018-2019.

The former parish schools also showed a slight decline in the combined deficit, before subsidy and special income, from \$1.210 million to \$1.156 million. After subsidy and \$420,000 in special PPP revenue, the 2019-20 fiscal year shows a combined surplus of \$173,637 compared to a combined deficit of \$194,425 in 2018-29.

The parish surpluses were a result of the expense savings from merging activities, as noted above, but also due to a 4% increase in our offertory collections (most of this was prior to the effects of COVID-19), and additional donations and bequests to the churches. With this surplus, along with the \$162,825 property sale at Our Lady of Grace, we were able to pay down the debt burden and past due obligations at OLG.

Our stated goal for this past fiscal year was to not operate in a deficit, and we are pleased to be able to say we achieved that goal. However, we know we cannot rely on property sales and bequests each year. We will continue to be good fiscal stewards of your donations to ensure the viability of each of our ministries and pastoral services. The finance council also works with me and my staff to keep a 5-year facilities maintenance and capital improvement plan to safeguard the beauty and safety of our facilities.

We remain committed to having a faith-filled parish with financial stability, and engaged ministries that demonstrate our Roman Catholic faith and practice, without fully depleting our financial reserves. Please pray for our efforts and continue to support our parish as God provides each of us by means of myriad gifts and talents. Know sincerely of my gratitude for your support of our beloved St. Michael the Archangel parish. Your efforts make an enormous difference not only for our faith community, but the entire community as well! Be assured of my daily prayers, and those of Frs. Barr and Gramc. I hope you will do the same for us and the Staff that faithfully serves us!






