On **Saturday, February 19 at 2:00 p.m.**, the Schola Gregoriana of the Saint Gregory Institute of Sacred Music, along with the Schola Cantorum of Most Precious Blood of Jesus Parish, Pittsburgh, will offer a liturgical performance of **Gabriel Fauré's** setting of the **Requiem** Mass.

The Mass, which will be offered for the Faithful Departed of the Diocese of Pittsburgh by the Reverend Canon William Avis, ICRSP, Pastor of Most Precious Blood Parish, will include Gregorian chant alongside Fauré's beloved music, accompanied by chamber orchestra and conducted by Nicholas Will and John Rokosz (chant). The Requiem is being co-sponsored by Most Precious Blood of Jesus Parish and the Saint Gregory Institute of Sacred Music and is open to the public.

This represents a rare opportunity to experience Fauré's masterpiece in its original liturgical context—that of the pre-Vatican II ("Tridentine") Roman Catholic Mass.

Once inside, she promptly asked for two things: shoes to replace her sandals and the restroom? She asked if she could go first because she had a job interview in an hour and hadn’t been able to clean her face yet.

People from all backgrounds and stories come to our doors in Downtown Pittsburgh, but they all share two things: A desperate need for safe daytime shelter and a reminder of their worth. Meanwhile, Catholic Charities has a desperate need for volunteers to help us deliver both.

Volunteers serve coffee and snacks, organize and distribute winter clothes and provide companionship.

If you’re vaccinated against COVID-19, 18 years or older, please consider joining us.

We provide the training; you provide the willing heart. Together, we’ll serve those on the brink of losing hope.

Vincetians are different! By Deacon Steve Deskevich

Greetings fellow Vincetians! I once commented in a homily that a lot of praying goes on every evening around 7:00 PM because that is when the Pennsylvania Lottery numbers are being drawn. Everyone is holding their ticket and saying, "God please let me win tonight; if I win, I will give to the Church; I will help out my family and friends and all those who need help. God, let me win just this one time!"

There are hundreds of dedicated Vincetians who are not waiting to hit the lottery to help those in need. One of the graces of our ministry is that people from all walks of life support our ministry through their generous financial contributions. That is us hitting God's lottery of love so we can share that love with those in need.

Every single day we encounter people who are on the margins of society. People who have lost their jobs, their health, and sometimes the friends and family who used to offer support. And we all know Covid has made our ministry all the more challenging.

Like many of you, I have tossed and turned at night, thinking about a client who is full of fear and short on hope. So often we place ourselves in the shoes of others, we share in their pain, and we struggle with the best way to help them in their time of need.

We need to constantly remind ourselves that we are not there just to pay a bill or refer them to an agency who can assist them. We are there to show them the love of Christ and offer them hope.

To be successful, our ministries must be rooted in prayer and Sacrament, and our lives should be a prayer of action, visible to all. We know none of this is possible on our own. Without the grace of God, we will burn out, become insensi- tive, and sometimes even cynical.

We must be different from other organizations who assist those in need. That is why our meetings begin and end with prayer. We also reflect on the Gospel to inspire and challenge us to see Jesus in the face of every person we encounter.

May we continually be encouraged by the fact that as we gather and pray, many of our sister and brother Vincetians all over the world are praying with us. In one spirit, let us be comforted and encouraged by the words of Jesus... "I assure you, as often as you did it for one of my least brothers, you did it for me" (Matthew 23:40).

St. Vincent de Paul, pray for us.

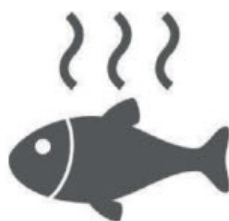
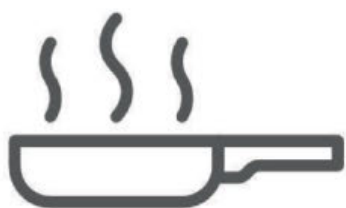

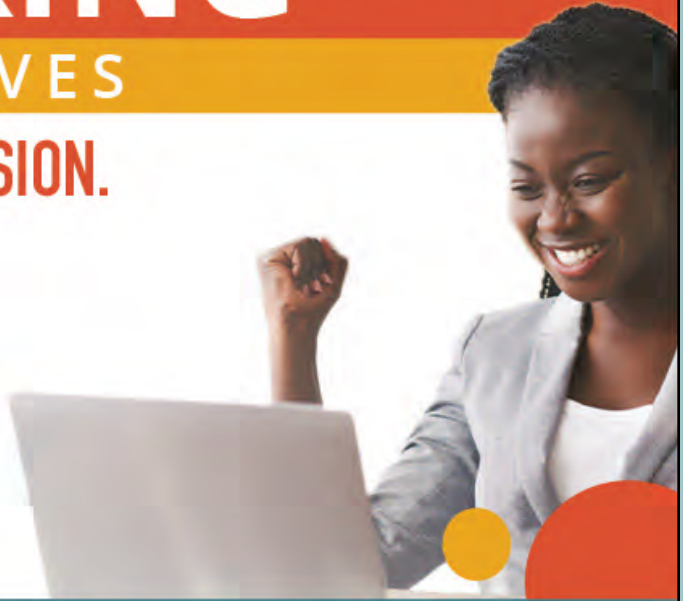
