## Father Brian's Desk

With the renewal that Spring always brings, I want you to be aware of some recent cosmetic changes we have been doing at both of our parish sites. You may remember past articles regarding the renewal of the outdoor gardens at our churches. At Our Lady of Grace, much work by our maintenance staff, Gerri Barnes, and the Musial Family has helped to renew the gardens surrounding the front of the church and the Marian grotto. Old bushes and trees have been removed, and new ones have been added. In addition, flowers will be planted. A large section of concrete pavement has been poured near the handicapped parking spaces close to the outside of the Marian Chapel. Concrete work was also done near the Bower Hill Road entrance. Much needed patchwork has been done to the roofs of the Our Lady of Grace gym (\$59,700); church (\$53,400) and rectory/garage (\$33,900), for an overall cost of \$147,000. These repairs will provide drainage as well as seam patching which will assist in some of the major leaks. While this is not a full proof protection of these roofs due to expense at the current time, this should be useful for a number of years, especially beneath the cupula (inside altar area) which has been a long-time problem. Some funds from recent bequests and from the gym and school rentals will offset these costs. My hope is to renovate the Our Lady of Grace Church building and social hall in the future.

Inside Our Lady of Grace Church, painting has commenced in the gallery/balcony area. Thanks to a generous donor, a new and worthy leather Gospel Book cover has been gifted for the enhancement of the Sacred Liturgy, as well as sets of chalice veils and burses for both churches in all of the liturgical colors of the Church year.

At the St. Bernard Church site, some new concrete has been poured in the plaza in a much needed area. Bruce Coleman continues to care for the flowers around the Marian grotto, while Lou Prosperi has re-planted nice canna lily bulbs for the side walls immediately outside of the church. The maintenance staff does much in the upkeep of the landscape as well. Due to water damage in the kitchen/storage area of Fontenay, new flooring and wall and ceiling patching has been completed.

I call your attention to two new men working on our maintenance staff at St. Michael the Archangel Parish: Mr. David Poliziano, who had worked at the former Our Lady of Grace Parish, and Mr. Dan Thornton, who with his wife and children, is a member of our parish family.

This coming week we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord, a major feast day and Holy Day of obligation. Please note the Mass times offered for the Vigil and Feast Day celebration.

The parish office will be closed on Ascension Thursday, May 26, and also Memorial Day, Monday, May 30.




