SMA DRESS A GIRL MINISTRY



Our SMA DRESS A GIRL MINISTRY has now donated over one thousand dresses to this international ministry of Dress a Girl Around the World which, in turn, is a ministry of Hope 4 Women International. Women's Guild member Margie Prince and her husband made the most recent drive to Akron, OH to DAG Ambassador Michelle B. They were able to deliver 330 dresses and 206 dolls to bring our four-year totals to 1180 and 645 respectively. With travel regulations easing, Michelle consistently receives requests from various missionaries and orphanages around the world requesting dresses for young girls. All dresses are hand delivered to requestors to ensure they are not diverted to black market.

Hope 4 Women International is a 501(c)(3) organization founded in 2008 to bring dignity to women around the world. H4WI is a nondenominational independent Christian organization formed for charitable and educational purposes. Specifically, they began to empower women in Uganda, who continue to suffer from poverty, disease, and low self-worth, to become self-sufficient with businesses of their own.

Dress a Girl Around the World is a Campaign under H4WI. "We dream of a world in which every girl has at least one new dress. We want girls to know that they are worthy of respect, and that they are loved by God."

Our SMA Dress-a-Girl group has grown from about six women in 2019 to about twenty regulars. Some women prefer to sew at home, some enjoy the company of sewing with others at Keefer, and some have developed an affection for doll-making. Friendships have developed over the years. And how precious the sound of laughter coming from the small groups!

Many thanks to everyone who has contributed to this ministry in any way. We are always grateful for donations of cotton fabric as well as monetary. The group is taking a break for the summer and will resume Friday, September 9, 2022.



Ancient yet timeless, the glorious chant of the Catholic Church waits to sound this summer from the young voices of children, reaching for the heavens. St. Michael the Archangel Parish's Children's Chant Camp provides the perfect setting for children to become eager participants in their Catholic heritage through immersion in the sung prayers of the church, both Ordinaries and Propers.

At Children's Chant Camp, children in Grades 3-8 receive professional instruction in reading traditional chant notation, articulating the language of the Latin Church, and employing proper vocal techniques for choral singing, while continuing to develop a lifelong appreciation of their faith. The chants, essential parts of the Mass, and lovely choral works learned during the week contribute to a beautiful and inspiring First Friday liturgy presented by the camp participants.

As there are many young people involved in our parish, adults who participate in any parish ministry must be in compliance with the Safe Environment policy. *Therefore, you must complete the necessary clearances prior to participating in any parish activity*.



Giving to St. Michael the Archangel Parish through your Will or Trust

When considering gifts to St. Michael the Archangel think about:

Planned Giving

- A specific dollar amount.
- A percentage of your estate.
- A particular asset such as real estate, stocks or other valuables.

You can designate which program or ministry will benefit from your donation.

(Parish Share, General Donation, Operations or a specific ministry)

Keep in mind that monies collected above and beyond our assessed Parish Share figure remain in the parish free from assessment meaning that we will get the full value of each dollar beyond that amount. The overflow from this campaign each year has helped to fund parish operations in each parish.

Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD)

As a result of the recent Federal tax law changes, more taxpayers will use the standard deduction instead of itemizing deductions. Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD) allow taxpayers an alternative means to obtain a tax break for giving to a qualified charity. The QCD permits taxpayers to transfer money from their traditional IRA directly to a qualified charity without the distribution being added to their adjusted gross income, thus reducing their Federal Income Tax. Donations of up to \$100,000 annually may be made and taxpayers must be 70 1/2 years or older to be eligible.

Support our mission and vision anywhere, anytime.
Join the over 1600 parishioners currently giving online.

Visit our website to sign up and to begin contributing automatically to our parishes. This convenient system does not require you to contact your bank to sign up or to make changes. You can use any of your checking and savings accounts or credit cards and the funds will be automatically transferred to our parish bank account. This system is more convenient for the parish than electronic checks from your bank. And it's convenient for you because you can make changes at any time.

It uses safe and secure encrypted account information and integrates into our parish record system. You can see reports on your contribution history and generate tax statements at each year's end.

Go to <u>smapph.org</u> to get started Click the "Give" tab, click "Create An Account" and follow the easy set up instruction. For those who already participate, the online giving link has changed so if you have the link saved, you will need to resave it. Simply follow the directions above to navigate to the new online giving page and save the link that appears in your browser.


