Congratulations and best wishes to Deacon Fred Eckhardt upon his retirement!



Please join us at the 11am Holy Mass this Sunday, June 12, 2022 as we acknowledge the retirement of Deacon Fred Eckhardt. Reception to follow 11am Mass in Clairvaux Hall.

Following his ordination to the diaconate on June 11, 2011, Deacon Fred was assigned to Saint Bernard Parish on July 1, 2011. On October 15, 2018, with the grouping of the parishes of Saint Bernard and Our Lady of Grace, Deacon Fred was assigned to Our Lady of Grace as well. Deacon Fred continued his service to Saint Michael the Archangel Parish when the two parishes merged in 2020.

He has served all three parishes with dedication in his assistance to the priests and genuine pastoral care for all our parishioners. His sense of humor and succinct homilies are treasures from which we have all received and benefitted!

Although his retiring will limit his service in ministry, we are glad that Deacon Fred and his lovely wife, Sue Ann, are actual members of our parish, and we will therefore see them.

Spiritans Missionary Co-op

One of the ways the Roman Catholic Church is deeply inspirational is through her missionary work. For millennia, the Church has sent forth innumerable Catholic missionaries to bring relief to the poor. We serve women, children, and men of all races and religions. The Church pursues the poor and serves them because poverty is painful. There is no other litmus test.

This year, Missionary Cooperation Sunday in our parish will be the weekend of June 25th and 26th. As with the past couple of years, because of restrictions we will not host a missionary.

Our parish this year is supporting the Spiritans, officially Congregation of the Holy Spirit and formerly known as the Holy Ghost Fathers and Brothers. The Spiritans are the founders of Duquesne University and continue to be a visible presence on campus today. They work around the world with the most vulnerable, addressing severe food shortages by bringing food, water, medical services and supplies to our brothers and sisters who lack these necessities of life, teaching them career skills, operating hospitals and schools, and providing for their daily needs.

Realizing that it has been a difficult few years for all of us, we can only imagine how difficult it has been for people who live in countries with no or very few safety nets. Please be as generous as possible through prayer and financial support in helping to offer the safety net that the Spiritans are providing for vulnerable people throughout the world.

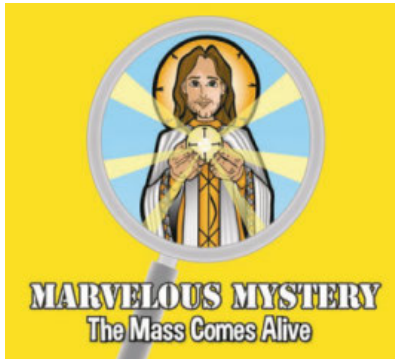

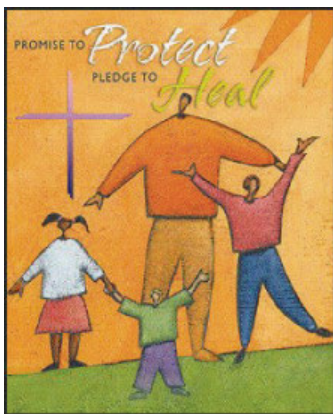

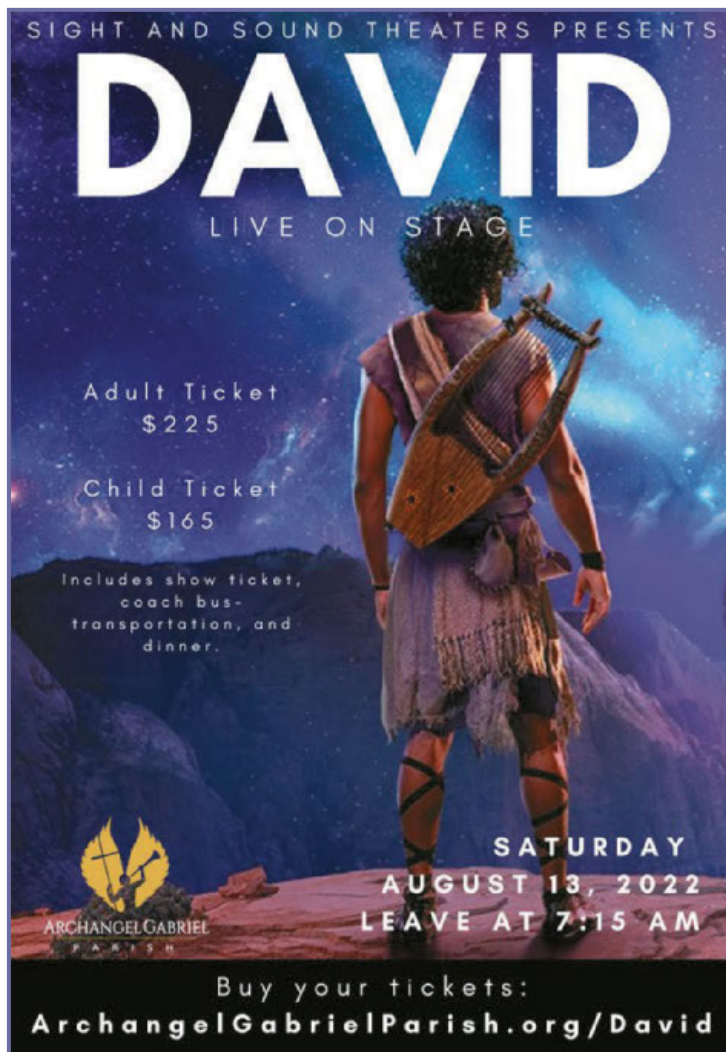
