Corpus Christi



As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ this weekend, a special year begins prompted by the US Catholic Bishops, to promote a greater catechesis and understanding of Christ's Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. In our Catholic teaching, what appears to be bread and wine (the accidents), is no longer bread and wine following the consecration, but the very risen Body and Blood of our Savior. That is why our external bodily gestures of genuflecting, bowing and kneeling before our Eucharistic Savior professes this fundamental and foundational apostolic belief of the Church. I'm glad as Pastor that this past academic year we have had adult education both on the celebration of the Mass and the Sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist to strengthen and confirm our understanding of this precious gift.

This Sunday, the tradition of our parish is to hold an outdoor procession with the Holy Eucharist. Many such processions will be held outdoors publically on this Solemnity throughout the world where permitted. I hope many will attend! Two things that I ask we bear in mind:

- (1.) When we receive the Body and Blood of Christ worthily (without conscious mortal or grave sin) we become what we receive.

 Jesus' Real Presence in us sacramentally assists us in living the moral praxis of a holy life in accord with the Commandments of God, which is His Divine Will.
- (2.) When we are permitted to take the most august Sacrament into the streets of our community, it is a two-fold blessing. It sanctifies our community by driving away evil as we sing and adore God's Real Presence in the world. And we give witness to the transformation that the gift of the Eucharist brings to our lives as we receive Him and adore Him. It is a transformation that has the potential to make us saints.

I'm very grateful that we can do this in our community. There is much casual acceptance of immorality in our world today that corrupts our children, destroys hope, and wounds individuals and our society. The positive influence of religion by people who genuinely embrace the whole of their faith, humbly and lovingly, will help many people who are misinformed, to recognize the truth and beauty of the faith and the manner in which it is lived, and bring people to eternal salvation. May our bells announce the arrival of our Eucharistic Lord and King, both in our church and in the streets!

at St. Bernard Church of our parish
and/or the reception to be held in Clairvaux Hall immediately afterward,
as we bid God's Blessings and strength for Fr. Tom Gramc in his new assignment,
effective on July 1, 2022.



A parish community is always buzzing with worship experiences and activities that include youth participants. Beyond Sunday Mass and Religious Education programs, you will find Children's Liturgy of the Word, Vacation Bible School, Youth Ministry, the Parish Festival, the fish fry, and much more. Spiritans Missionary Co-op



One of the ways the Roman Catholic Church is deeply inspirational is through her missionary work. For millennia, the Church has sent forth innumerable Catholic missionaries to bring relief to the poor. We serve women, children, and men of all races and religions. The Church pursues the poor and serves them because poverty is painful. There is no other litmus test.

This year, Missionary Cooperation Sunday in our parish will be the weekend of June 25th and 26th. As with the past couple of years, because of restrictions we will not host a missionary.

Our parish this year is supporting the Spiritans, officially Congregation of the Holy Spirit and formerly known as the Holy Ghost Fathers and Brothers. The Spiritans are the founders of Duquesne University and continue to be a visible presence on campus today. They work around the world with the most vulnerable, addressing severe food shortages by bringing food, water, medical services and supplies to our brothers and sisters who lack these necessities of life, teaching them career skills, operating hospitals and schools, and providing for their daily needs.

Realizing that it has been a difficult few years for all of us, we can only imagine how difficult it has been for people who live in countries with no or very few safety nets. Please be as generous as possible through prayer and financial support in helping to offer the safety net that the Spiritans are providing for vulnerable people throughout the world.






