Father Brian's Desk

It is with profound thanksgiving that we bid Father Tom Gramc best wishes today as he embarks on his new assignment, effective July 1, as Administrator of the grouping in Garfield/Bloomfield and Lawrenceville! The first pastoral assignment for a priest is very special. Though Fr. Gramc in his first year of ordination completed his studies in Rome, St. Bernard Church and then the grouping of St. Bernard-Our Lady of Grace, became his first pastoral assignment. Oddly enough, when I was in my first assignment at St. Sebastian Church in Ross Township, also after having finished a year in Rome following ordination to complete my studies, Father Gramc was a young child in the parish grade school. How interesting are the ways of the Lord that we would work together as priests! Later, I would meet Father Gramc again while he was in formation, when I was given the charge of seminarians in various capacities.

Father Tom has learned so much in his pastoral work here at the parish long before my arrival and since my time here which has prepared him well for his next assignment. What a great assistance he has been for me in making a transition from Administrative duties in the Chancery back to pastoral work, and during the COVID pandemic. I am indebted to him for his counsel and assistance, but also the fraternal priestly life we have shared that has given strength to our pastoral care in this parish.

At a young age, Father Tom exhibits a keen sense of the Catholic priesthood; its spiritual life and grave responsibility, as well as a balance of life that includes prayer, exercise and the pastoral care of parishioners, as well as administrative skills! We wish him the grace and peace of Jesus, the Good Shepherd, as he now goes to care as spiritual father for his new flock. As pastor, I would like to acknowledge his parents, Tom and Kathleen Gramc, whom I have also known for a while now, and his family with whom he is close and who are no strangers to our parish family of St. Michael the Archangel. I'm very happy they could share in our celebration of thanks to Father Gramc today.

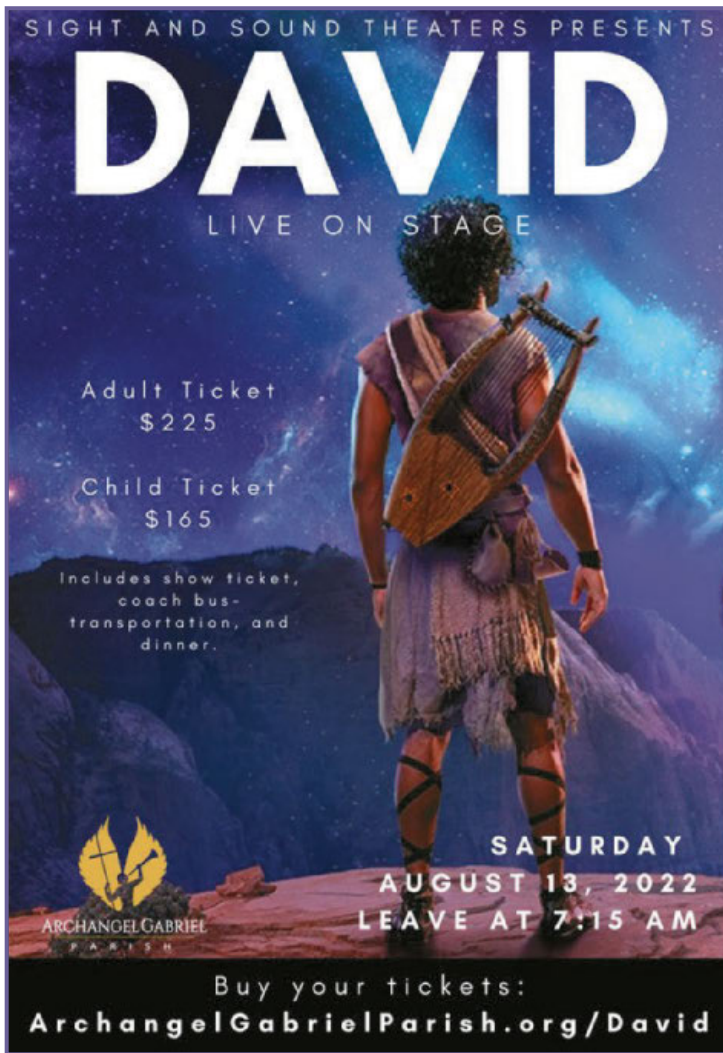

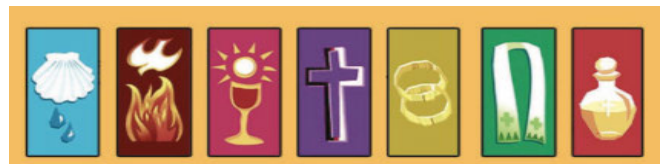
