Father Brian's Desk

As we celebrate Independence Day this year, I cannot help but think of a victory in the spiritual battle that was won for our country on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the traditional date of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, which was transferred to 7/23 in accommodation of both Solemnities. I am speaking of the ruling of the Supreme Court of the United States that declared it is not a constitutional right to abort a child in its mother's womb. God is in the details of that victory...believe it! Those liturgical feasts are greatly significant. It is God's love and the cooperation of good men and women that are in the battle to preserve the sanctity of life in the womb, which in turn supports the dignity of the life of every human being from conception until natural death. The judgement of God is upon us individually and collectively, and so our response in the spiritual battle according to the gifts and knowledge that God has gifted us with, has to do with our eternal salvation or our eternal damnation.

The work for the sanctity of life continues, as we are yet far from the ultimate victory of protecting the preeminent right of life for all unborn children in our American society, though the Supreme Court result is definitively a victory for which we need to offer thanks to Almighty God!

In support of this continued battle for life, I am announcing a monthly all night adoration on the second Tuesday of the month in the Fontenay Chapel from 4 p.m. Tuesday, until 6:40 a.m. Wednesday morning, before the Wednesday 7 a.m. Mass. So adoration will now occur on the second Tuesday in Fontenay Chapel to accommodate the larger crowd in the earlier hours. The second Tuesday date upon which this will commence will be July 12. Details will follow for sign-up regarding all night adoration. The express intention is for continued movement in our country for an end to abortion and assistance to women with difficult pregnancies. Perhaps we can increase this to weekly all-night adoration if possible in the future for other intentions. We can see how sign-ups develop and get a read from committed adorers. Prayer obtains all things in light of Divine Providence!

In future bulletins I will announce some ideas and/or details regarding the following:

- *the establishment of a Confraternity of St. Michael the Archangel in our parish
- *a lecture in July about protecting our parish from harm
- *a lecture to be held the end of August by Fr. Adam Potter in support of Catholic sexual ethics in a growing hostile culture
- *the need for donations in the renovation of the organ at St. Bernard Church
- *the image of the Holy Face of Jesus
- *a wonderful article from the Wall Street Journal of which parishioners told me about the podcast of our own, Fr. Anthony along with his friend, Fr. Ayre, who was humble and did not tell me!


