



SAFE ENVIRONMENT AT SMA



A parish community is always buzzing with worship experiences and activities that include youth participants. Beyond Sunday Mass and Religious Education programs, you will find Children's Liturgy of the Word, Vacation Bible School, Youth Ministry, the Parish Festival, the fish fry, and much more. As there are many young people involved in our parish, adults who participate in any parish ministry must be in compliance with the Safe Environment policy. Therefore, you must complete the necessary clearances prior to participating in any parish activity.


Are you missing our weekly updates?

Keep in mind that monies collected above and beyond our assessed Parish Share figure remain in the parish free from assessment meaning that we will get the full value of each dollar beyond that amount. The overflow from this campaign each year has helped to fund parish operations in each parish.

Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD)

As a result of the recent Federal tax law changes, more taxpayers will use the standard deduction instead of itemizing deductions. Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD) allow taxpayers an alternative means to obtain a tax break for giving to a qualified charity. The QCD permits taxpayers to transfer money from their traditional IRA directly to a qualified charity without the distribution being added to their adjusted gross income, thus reducing their Federal Income Tax. Donations of up to \$100,000 annually may be made and taxpayers must be 70 1/2 years or older to be eligible.






