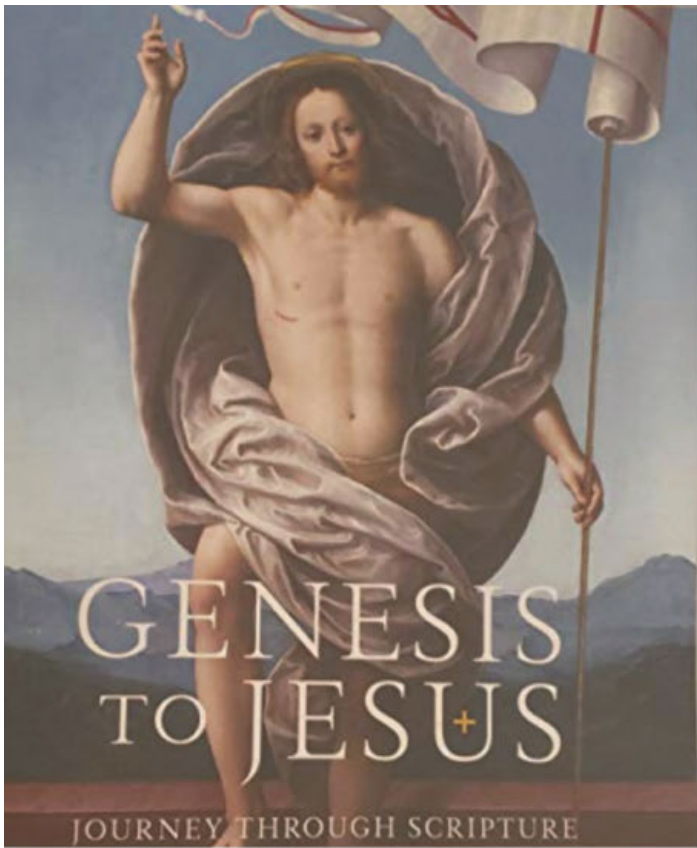

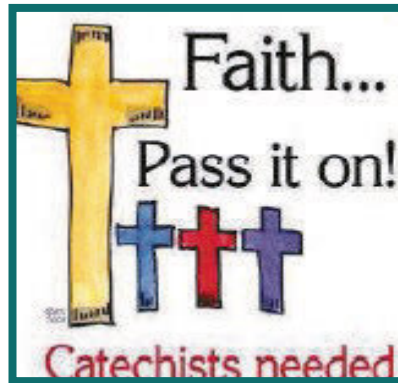

A LIFELINE FOR MARRIED COUPLES

Living in a marriage that is missing love can be painful and miserable. If you have given up hope that your marriage can and will get better, ask your spouse to consider attending a Retrouvaille program. Retrouvaille is an international Christian-based ministry that offers a program to help couples improve their marriages and rediscover the love they once shared, no matter how bad it may be, even for separated and divorced couples. It is an eight-week program that begins with an in-person weekend retreat. The initial weekend is followed by seven weekly four-hour virtual follow-up sessions. An optional, ongoing monthly meeting is offered to couples for support and growth. It is not counseling or group therapy, and you will not share your struggles with others. What happens when you give a friar a fiddle or a set of spoons?

You wind up with The Hillbilly Thomists! Join us on **Thursday, July 28 at 7:00 PM at Hyacinth Epp Hall, 224 37th St., Pittsburgh 15201**. Invite your family, friends, and anyone who loves bluegrass, Americana, or music of any kind.

The Hillbilly Thomists are a band of Friars of the Order of Preachers. After playing music together for several years, they released their self-titled debut album in 2017, which reached #3 on the Billboard Bluegrass Chart and consisted mostly of bluegrass standards and Americana favorites. Album #2, *Living for the Other Side*, followed in 2021. Since then, the friars in the band have been doing what Dominican friars do: contemplating, studying, and preaching. They've also been writing more songs. The fruit of all this is their new album, *Holy Ghost Power*, released just this month. Recorded at the Alberthaus in the Catskills and featuring original songs, the new album is a resonant and at times rollicking meditation on grace, suffering, faith, conversion, and the soul's dogged desire for what really matters.

These bluegrass-playing Dominicans have been featured on EWTN, National Catholic Register, Aleteia, Bluegrass Today, First Things, The American Conservative, and many other publications for one simple reason: they're amazing! From classic tunes such as "Just as I Am" to originals like "*Bourbon, Bluegrass, and the Bible*," the Hillbilly Thomists are a one-of-a-kind musical experience that the whole family can enjoy. Fr. Joseph (Patrick) Hagan O.P. (spoons, washboard, drums) is from the South Hills and graduated from St Bernard School.

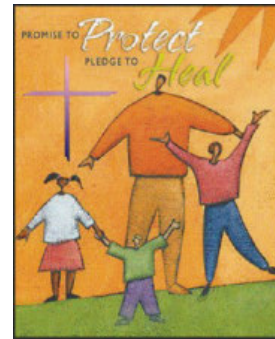
