## Father Brian's Desk

Words are not adequate to express my thanks as Pastor of our parish for all of the labor and effort behind our annual Michaelmas Festival this weekend, from all of the volunteers and the staff of our parish. The purpose is three-fold: a parish fundraiser, a moment to draw our parish and wider community together, and to honor our parish patron – St. Michael the Archangel. That is why we have a number of events connected with the festival, both recreational and spiritual. It is a tremendous effort and worthwhile as we continue to foster unity and grow as a new parish. Thank you!

As I mentioned a few weeks ago regarding the Mass schedule and Fr. Gramc's new assignment with no replacement, I am currently working with a religious order to help cover Masses each weekend from September until December on a trial basis. I will continue to look at the numbers for each weekend, and in January begin to discuss any Mass changes or how to best move forward in service to our parish and its spiritual growth.



Plans are underway for the establishment of a parish Confraternity of St. Michael the Archangel. This will be a confraternity to establish devotion to our patron saint, offer an opportunity for public devotion, private prayer and fasting for our parish's spiritual growth, and to assist and foster four major processions in the Church year: Corpus Christi and Good Friday night at St. Bernard; and the Michaelmas procession and Rosary/Marian procession at Our Lady of Grace. ## SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM AT SAINT MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL PARISH

Jesus commissioned the eleven remaining Apostles to make disciples of *all* nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Congratulations on your commitment to further His great commission by baptizing your baby at St. Michael the Archangel Parish! We know this is a very exciting and blessed time for you and your family, and we rejoice with you.

If this is your *first* baby, email Deacon Eric Schorr at [eschorr@smapgh.org](mailto:eschorr@smapgh.org) to set up a time to meet, preferably before your baby is born. Your meeting with Deacon Eric gives you the opportunity to meet with a member of the parish clergy team to learn more about our parish and having your child baptized. We want to get to know your family better!

After your meeting with Deacon Eric, you will attend our Baptism Formation Evening for New Parents. These evenings are held every -other-month. You will receive the dates of the evenings at your meeting with Deacon Eric.

You will be able to schedule your baby's baptism *after* you have met with Deacon Eric and attended the Baptism Formation Evening.

If this *isn't* your first baby to be baptized and it has been *more than three years* since you have attended our Baptism Formation Evening for New Parents, you will need to meet with Deacon Eric before you schedule your baby's baptism.



Living in a marriage that is missing love can be painful and miserable. If you have given up hope that your marriage can and will get better, ask your spouse to consider attending a Retrouvaille program. Retrouvaille is an international Christian-based ministry that offers a program to help couples improve their marriages and rediscover the love they once shared, no matter how bad it may be, even for separated and divorced couples. It is an eight-week program that begins with an in-person weekend retreat. The initial weekend is followed by seven weekly four-hour virtual follow-up sessions. An optional, ongoing monthly meeting is offered to couples for support and growth. It is not counseling or group therapy, and you will not share your struggles with others.
