From the Desk of Father Brian

St. Michael the Archangel Vocation Council regularly prays at meetings and Eucharistic Holy Hours for the fruit of vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life in our parish, as well as the spiritual stability of the ordained clergy and consecrated religious. It is an important Apostolate of our parish family. The fruit of their spiritual labor, and many individual parishioners in our parish who pray for this intention, is seen not only in past vocations now thriving, but in those pursuing a vocation currently in the Church. Please continue to pray for those pursuing vocations in our parish, and the spiritual strength and growth in holiness of the priests, deacons and consecrated religious of the Diocese of Pittsburgh! You might consider joining the Vocation Council as a means of dedicated prayer for this purpose. Here is some good news regarding our parish vocations that you should know about:

Seminarian John Kist, son of Mr. and Mrs. Timothy and Claire Kist of our parish, was admitted to Candidacy on December 4, 2022 last month at St. Katherine Drexel Parish wherein he served his recent pastoral year. He is back at Theological College and Catholic University in Washington, D.C. We are looking forward to his ordination as a transitional Deacon this coming June, 2023. More will follow on this special event in future bulletin announcements.

Jarek Sulak, a parishioner and son of Mr. and Mrs. Chris and Deb Sulak of Texas, and Christoph Bernas, son of Mr. and Mrs. Bradley and Julia Bernas of our parish, both entered St. Paul Seminary this past August, and are discerning a vocation to the priesthood. Jarek successfully completed his bar exams following law school this past summer, and entered the Pre-theology program, while Christoph left his studies at Penn State and entered his second year of collegiate program. Our seminarians live at St. Paul Seminary in Crafton, and travel to Franciscan University for Philosophical studies.

Matthew Broeren, C.S.Sp., son of Mr. and Mrs. John and Jane Broeren of our parish, renewed his vows in the Congregation of the Spiritans in Brazil this past July, while on assignment doing missionary work. He has written in our bulletin in the past about his vocation and past missionary work in Trinidad. Eventually Matthew will return to the States for more theological studies in pursuit of the holy priesthood.

Finally, Chidera Ohamara, a parishioner, was recently received as a Postulant on September 11 of this past year into the Bernadine Franciscan Sisters at the Sacred Heart Convent Chapel of Reading, Pennsylvania.
