# **Lenten Regulations**



The Catholic observance of Lent includes days of fast and abstinence. On these days, people age 14 and older are obliged to abstain from eating meat, while healthy people ages 18-59 are to fast by limiting themselves to one full meal and two lighter meals.

# Days of fast and abstinence:

Ash Wednesday (February 22) and Good Friday (April 7) Fridays of Lent

Those with a medical condition which makes fasting inadvisable are not obliged to fast, but should perform some other act of penance or charity.


