### From the Desk of Father Brian

### With gratitude to Our Lord, we are pleased to make the following announcement:

Mr. John L. Kist, son of Claire and Timothy Kist, of our parish, has been called by his Bishop, the Most Reverend David A. Zubik, D.D., to the Order of Diaconate to be conferred at an ordination ceremony to be held on Saturday, June 3, 2023, in Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish, Saint Sebastian Church, Ross Township.



I would like to encourage all parishioners to a special liturgical event previously announced, that is, a devotion to the Mother of God that comes from the Byzantine Church. This will assist us in honoring our Blessed Mother as we traditionally do in the month of May. We will have guests from the neighboring parish of St. Gregory Nazianzen Byzantine Catholic Parish in Upper St. Clair to assist us to chant and to pray the Akathist hymn to the Mother of God on Wednesday, May 24, 7 p.m. at St. Bernard Church of our parish. I first came to knowledge of this prayer when St. John Paul II asked that all Cathedrals of the world have it prayed during the Marian year of 1988. It is one of the most beloved services in the Byzantine Church, both Catholic and Orthodox. It was composed in the imperial city of Constantinople, "the city of the Virgin," by St. Romanos the Melodist, who reposed in the year 556 A.D. Please come and experience this special event celebrated in the Byzantine Rite. Father Valerian Michlik, Pastor of St. Gregory with lead with his chant group, and we hope also to have Father Jason Charron to preach, pastor of Holy Trinity Ukrainian Catholic Church as well.





### "SEND FORTH YOUR SPIRIT, O LORD" Music for Pentecost




As the Holy Spirit descends upon God's people, it brings with it seven gifts to help us follow the way of the Lord: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord. These gifts work in synergy with the seven virtues of faith, hope, charity, prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance to "help man to transcend the limitations of human reason and human nature and participate in the very life of God" (Thomas Aquinas). The Introit Antiphon for the Vigil Mass says, "I will sprinkle clean water upon you, and you shall be cleansed from all your filthiness."

The music of Pentecost is rich with imagery of fire, wind, and water, as well as themes of perfect love of God. "Come Down, O Love Divine" draws on the beatitudes as exemplars of the marriage of gifts and virtues to become one with God. The Responsorial Psalm, "Lord, Send Out Your Spirit," implores the Spirit to help perfect our lives with God to secure eternity with Him. The Pentecost sequence, "Veni, Sancte Spiritus," gives thanks for the many gifts the Spirit has provided. "Come Holy Ghost" is among the many hymns and chants that call down the gentle power of the Spirit.

The combined St. Hildegard and St. Cecilia choirs will sing at both the Pentecost Vigil Mass, Saturday, May 27th at 4:00 PM, Our Lady of Grace Church and Pente-

cost Mass of the Day on Sunday, May 28th at 11:00 AM, St. Bernard Church. We hope you'll join us to celebrate as the gifts of the Spirit "renew the face of the earth."




