SOLEMNITY OF SS. MICHAEL, GABRIEL AND RAPHAEL, ARCHANGELS



The feast day of Ss. Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, Archangels, according to liturgical law is transferred in our parish to the nearest Sunday, and is granted the rank of Solemnity since St. Michael the Archangel is our principal patron. This gives to all of our faithful the opportunity to celebrate the mystery of the Archangels and specifically that of St. Michael, in a liturgical manner. As you may have noted, in solidarity with an ancient medieval tradition that was begun with St. Francis of Assisi, we have been preparing for our parish feast day since the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary. We had our "Michaelmas" festival after the Assumption with the procession of the image of St. Michael and the chanting of his litany, our recessional hymns each weekend have been in honor of St. Michael, we have been celebrating our annual 3-day Triduum with our neighboring "Archangel" parishes of St. Raphael and Archangel Gabriel, and finally we are graced to have Bishop David Zubik, as our main celebrant at the 4:00 pm Vigil Mass at Our Lady of Grace Church of our parish on the evening of September 30, and the 11:00 am Mass at St. Bernard Church of our parish on October 1. I hope that many of our parishioners will be able to attend one of those Masses on this weekend, although all the Masses will be celebrated accordingly as a parish solemnity.

Welcome, Bishop Zubik! Thank you for coming to share the joy of our patronal saint, Saint Michael the Archangel, whom we love and invoke daily, and manifesting your pastoral care over our flock of St. Michael the Archangel Parish. May Archangel Michael watch over and defend you in your ministry of care over the Diocese of Pittsburgh, and the spiritual and temporal needs of our parish!





Mission Appeal at St Michael the Archangel Parish October 7/8 BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT SISTERS OF ST. MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL



The Sisters of St. Michael the Archangel are an active female Religious Congregation, founded in 1986 in Nigeria. The Sisters provide direct care to the poor and the sick; they provide a safe haven for abandoned and elderly in need. Their healing comes through spiritual and physical care with a loving sense of home and family. They provide shelter and accommodations including food and other materials, and financial assistance for abandoned and motherless babies/children. The Sisters go about caring for the sick and infirm as Jesus did in towns and villages through mobile clinics, they also offer free and cheap health care services for the less privileged who cannot afford to go to hospitals. They provide education for the less privileged children in elementary and high schools. They also assist young women in vocational school. In addition, the Sisters work to bring the gospel of Christ to all especially in remote areas by involving in pastoral work in different parishes in more than 12 dioceses in Nigeria. This includes teaching Catechism to Catechumens, and helping to prepare catechists; they also serve as director of Religious education in parishes and at the Diocesan level. They are also involved in organizing basic Christian communities among parishioners to strengthen their faith.






