SACRAMENT INFORMATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must pre-register for the session. Baptisms are celebrated during Mass, following the last Mass on Sunday, or by special arrangement. Please schedule by calling the Parish Office.

First Reconciliation/Eucharist – Children entering the 2nd & 3rd grades and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including St. Gregory Parish School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions. Sacraments are celebrated in late winter and spring.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation program. Sessions begin in the fall and Confirmation is celebrated in the spring.

Matrimony – Call the Parish Office at least 6 months prior to the anticipated wedding date. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

Anointing of the Sick – The Sacrament is available to all those who are seriously ill or advanced in age. Please call the Parish Office to request a visit by the priest.

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:00 – 4:30 PM, or by request. There are two multi-parish celebrations during Advent and Lent.

Dear Members and Friends of the St. Gregory Parish Family,

“*Merry Christmas*” to each one of you and to all of you! May God bless you with happiness and peace as we celebrate both Christmas and the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph! It’s certainly a joy-filled weekend as we prayerfully consider the birth of our Lord and Savior as well as His call to live as a “*Holy Family*” in the world today.

The key to living as a “*Holy Family*,” my friends, comes to us from the Gospel proclaimed on Christmas Eve. Having journeyed to Bethlehem, and finding no room in the inn, Mary and Joseph make their way to a nearby stable. There, St. Luke tells us, “*Mary gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger.*” (Luke 2,7) Recalling that scene, and the wonderful way that Mary and Joseph embraced God’s “*Love-Gift*” to the waiting world, we are reminded that we are to welcome Jesus with the same eagerness and joy. That Jesus was not only born once, many years ago, but is continually reborn in those who wrap Him in the “*swaddling clothes*” of their minds and hearts. If we welcome Jesus in this way, really take Him into our lives, then we are bound to more closely imitate Him and live as part of a “*Holy Family*.”

As you are probably well aware, we pray the different “*Mysteries*” of the rosary on different days of the week. Sunday and Wednesday are the days dedicated to the “*Glorious Mysteries*.” Tuesday and Friday are set aside for us to consider the “*Sorrowful Mysteries*.” In the year 2002, St. John Paul II introduced us to the “*Luminous Mysteries*,” or the “*Mysteries of Light*,” to be prayed on Thursday. That leaves Monday and Saturday, both offering the opportunity to reflect on the “*Joyful Mysteries*.” Since Christmas falls on a Saturday this year, we are provided with an “*extra special*” occasion to consider these “*Joyful Mysteries*” that include “*the Incarnation*,” the birth of the very Son of God!

As you consider making the rosary part of your Christmas Prayer, please think about the many ways that these episodes, both preceding and following Jesus’ birth, relate to our own lives as God’s faithful people.

The “*Annunciation*” – Making Mary’s “*Yes*” personal as we welcome Jesus into our lives and do our best to follow His example in practical ways each and every day.

The “*Visitation*” – Offering a “*Merry Christmas*,” bringing the joy of Jesus to all those we visit and all of those who come to visit us, particularly during this festive holiday season.

The “*Nativity*” – Recognizing and celebrating the great gift of life and doing our best to pray for and work towards the protection of all life from the first moment of conception through natural death.

The “*Presentation in the Temple*” – Rejoicing in that great day we were brought to the font for Baptism, became a child of God, a brother or sister in Christ, and were welcomed into the Family of Faith. Encouraging the unbaptized to come to faith so that they might experience a similar joy.

The “*Finding in the Temple*” – Inviting people to worship with us, welcoming back those who have fallen away, reminding them of God’s unconditional love and acceptance no matter what the circumstances.

That’s what is so very important about our prayer of the Rosary, isn’t it, friends? Yes, thinking about how each particular episode relates to Jesus in His own time and place. And, yes, considering our own participation in each “*Mystery*” as we do our best to grow in faith, hope and charity. Please be assured that my prayer of the Rosary this Christmas will be in gratitude to God for the birth of our Savior and in thanksgiving for all of you and the wonderful ways you reflect God’s love as a Family of Faith. Certainly, I will also be remembering all of those who are included in our list of flower memorials and all of those who are now praying for us from their place with God. The church is always so beautifully decorated for the Christmas Season and is, in a way, a foreshadowing of the beauty of heaven!

One Christmas Eve, Pope Francis seized the opportunity to speak on the mystery of the Incarnation and living out the joy of Christmas. Noting that “*Bethlehem*” literally means “*house of bread*,” the Holy Father noted that, “*At Christmas, we on earth receive Jesus, the bread from heaven – we discover that the life of God can enter into our hearts and dwell there.*” (December 24, 2018) May God bless each and all of us as we do our best to welcome Jesus, embrace Jesus, and live out our identity as “*Christian*,” a member of His beloved “*Holy Family*.” Enjoy your day, the weekend, this wonderful Christmas Season!
