Dear Parishioner,



As we thank and honor all fathers on this **Father's Day**, Bishop Persico invited our diocesan family to also use this weekend to honor **St. Joseph, during this Year of St. Joseph**. The prayers and readings of this

weekend's Masses have been particularly chosen to honor St. Joseph. You will also notice a special flyer in today's bulletin with a prayer to St. Joseph which is a favorite of Pope Francis. St. Joseph is often in the background, not center stage like Jesus or Mary. He has been nicknamed "Silent Joseph" since we have no recorded words. Today's Gospel story simply states that **"When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took his wife into his home."** He put aside his questions of Mary's unexpected pregnancy, the existing social and religious traditions of the time, and any concern for public embarrassment. With all the "unknowns," he simply accepted God's will and trusted in God's grace to support him. I encourage you, with all your questions, to turn to St. Joseph especially with this special prayer that states **"Beloved Father, all my trust is in you..."**

Bishop Persico and the priests of our diocese will gather this week at St. Vincent College in Latrobe for our **Emmaus Convocation, June 20-24**. Begun in the early 80's, this program has been a source of spiritual nourishment and fraternity. You have always been kind enough to keep us in your daily prayer. In my absence, the parish office will be open as usual, Monday-Friday, 9:00-2:00. Emergency calls at the hospital will be covered by a priest who will not be attending the program.

Since we are three weeks from Memorial Day, I ask that, if you have not done so already, you follow the **Cemetery Guidelines and remove your decorations**. I completely understand your sincere desire to choose decorations to express your affection. However, with your desire not only to have the staff cut the grass but to weed eat around each monument, this is becoming more of a challenge. This year, there seems to be a variety of flags/banners and new solar items often placed at a significant distance from the monument making it very difficult to both cut grass and weed eat. Let's cooperate so that our parish cemetery is maintained in a dignified manner.




