

Dear Parishioner,



A special Holy Hour has been scheduled for this Thursday, January 20, beginning at 6:30. Please consider participating. The format is very simple: the Blessed Sacrament will be

exposed for private prayer, Scripture readings will follow along with brief periods of silence, a homily, and Benediction. Such a format allows us time to open our hearts to the presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. After we receive Holy Communion during Mass, we do not have much time for quiet, personal reflection. The Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament during a Holy Hour offers an opportunity for such personal prayer and adoration. "Hour" does not exactly mean 60 minutes; such a prayer service is normally about 45 minutes. I can assure you it will be time well spent.



You will notice in your envelope packet one marked "2022 Help Spread the Faith Collection." In writing to us, Bishop Persico mentioned how valuable technology (like Zoom and livestream), along with printed material

like the FAITH magazine, has been for him and our diocesan staff to communicate with us during this time of the pandemic. All of this is provided free of charge. I am pleased to see how many have been using our parish YouTube taping of Sunday Mass. Our Christmas Mass, for instance, had over 200 viewers. Thanks for whatever gift you can share.



Attention Ushers! You should receive a Memo from me this week seeking your interest in continuing to serve the parish as an Usher. From June 2020,

when churches were re-opened, we discontinued passing the collection basket and continue to have the baskets available as you enter church. A handful of Ushers have made themselves available to take care of the collection, to distribute bulletins, and to provide direction especially to our visitors. I am asking those who have been listed on our teams (which numbers close to 70 individuals) to respond to my Memo indicating your choice to continue or to retire from this ministry. If anyone who has not been an Usher is interested in serving the parish in this ministry, please let me know. The new schedule would begin in early March. I am grateful for the Altar Servers, Eucharistic Ministers, Greeters, Lectors, Organists, and Cantors who have been so faithful throughout the challenges of the Pandemic.
