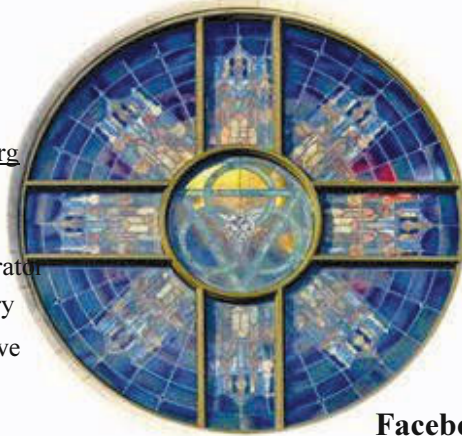

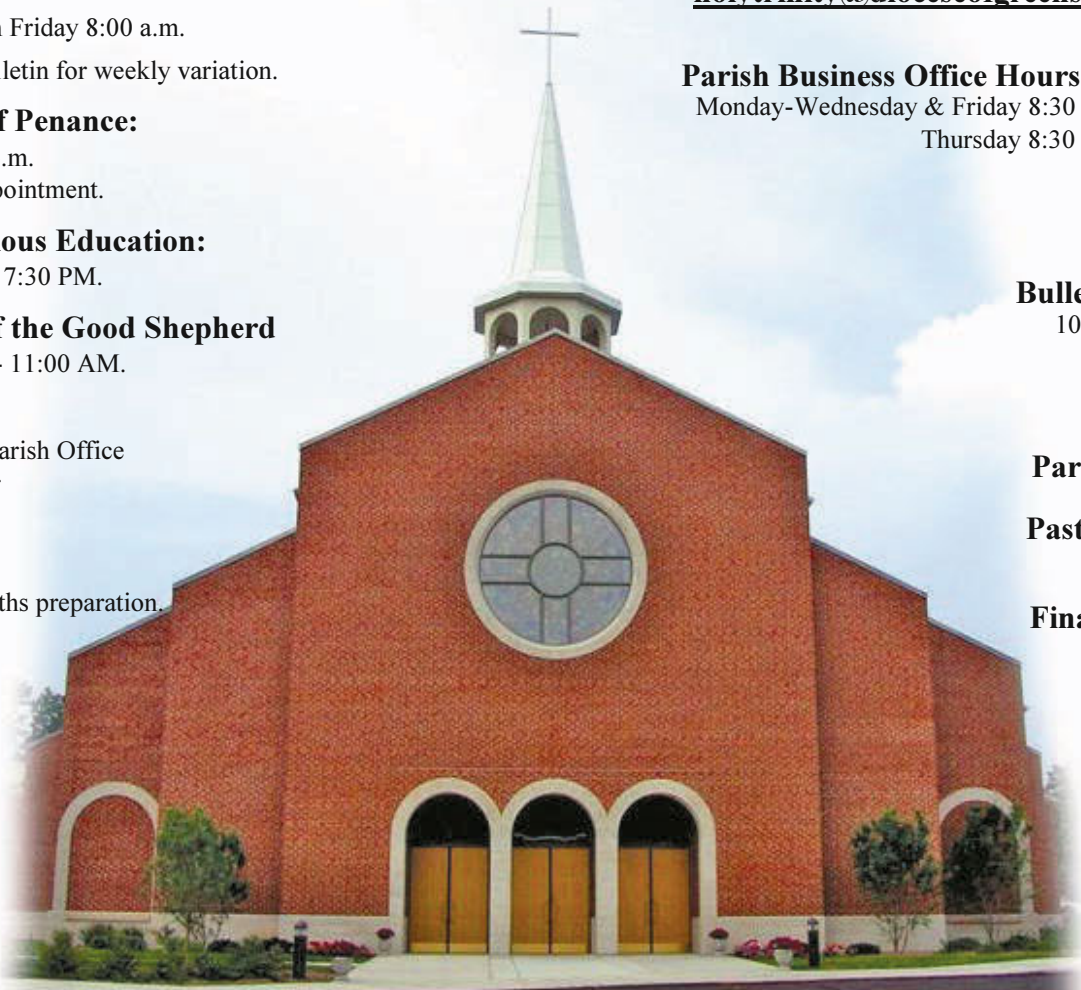

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ANTHONY.....

The best laid plans of mice and men..... About a month ago a member of my family notified me of a family event that would take place Saturday, August 20. Fr. Stephen, our reliable “weekend assistant,” had already informed me that he would be away from Ligonier the weekend of August 20-21. Because of Fr. Stephen’s absence, I arranged for a visiting priest to celebrate Mass on Saturday, August 20. Everything was in place, I thought. However, if you were here last Saturday, you know that our substitute priest did not come. I regret that we did not have Mass here last Saturday evening. I appreciate your patience.

Tina Komarinski, who was involved with Youth Faith Formation here at our parish, has resigned her position as of August 22, 2022. Let us pray that God will bless Tina in her future endeavors.

Last week I am sure you noticed the Faith Formation registration materials in the bulletin. We are slated to start Monday, September 12. The Monday night sessions are for all parishioners in grades one – twelve. As I mentioned last week, we are planning on a high school group this year – a few persons have already expressed interest. Details regarding sacramental preparation – First Confession, First Eucharist, and Confirmation – will be announced soon. Children anticipating the celebration of these three Sacraments should be registered for Faith Formation.

In more Faith Formation news, I am happy to announce that Lisa Klancher, one of our faithful catechists, has been hired for the position of Faith Formation Administrative Assistant. Lisa will assist with registration, ordering, and other administrative details. I am confident that Lisa will add some efficiency to our processes here that has been missing for the last two years. Lisa will usually be available in the Faith Formation Office on Monday afternoons and early evenings. I am grateful to Lisa for coming to our assistance, and I once again want to express my gratitude to all of our dedicated catechists who share their faith with our young parishioners.

As you know, Faith Formation is for all ages – we are never too old to be formed on our journey to eternal life with God. One of the greatest blessings that the parishioners of Holy Trinity have is our participation in FORMED, the online resource for so many faith formation materials. You might know that the Bishops of the United States are encouraging us to be revitalized in our Eucharistic Faith and Worship. Take a look at www.formed.org for a few short videos regarding the Eucharist: *Presence: The Mystery of the Eucharist; What Do Catholics Believe about the Eucharist?; How to Receive Communion Well; and Real + True: Eucharistic Revival*. The videos range in length from a few minutes to about a half hour. I hope you will take the time to renew your faith in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Are you interested in receiving a daily reflection in your email? You can register for the reflections at www.daily.formed.org.

The Ligonier Highland Games will take place at Idlewild Park on Saturday, September 17. The organizers of the Games have informed us that many of the attendees requested Bingo, and the organizers wanted to know if our parish could staff it. The profits would be ours. Anyone interested? Please let me know.

Is it back to school time already? I know that some are preparing to go back. God’s blessings on all of our students, their parents, teachers, aids, and everyone else who is involved with education. Let’s pray for a good year – I pray that students and teachers will be able to be in the classroom all year.

I continue to encourage any person who is interested in becoming Catholic to contact me in order that we can begin the process for the reception of the Sacraments! Please let me know if you are interested.

Be on the lookout for information about the next Book Discussion Group – we hope to have something in place for the Fall.
