A Teaching Moment...

We commemorate the faithful departed on November 2nd each year. However, we can and should continue to pray for the dead. Our growth in Christian perfection takes a long time. At the time of our death, many of us might not be saints yet. But God, in His mercy, allows for those who love Him to experience purification after death. Our word for that state is *Purgatory*. It's the antechamber of heaven, so to speak. We know we're getting into heaven, but we're not quite ready to go there yet. Here on earth we can pray for the souls in Purgatory. One way is to request that your parish offer a Mass for the intention of a specific loved one. We can also remember the departed in our daily prayers. Just as we have special intentions for family and friends here on earth, we can pray for those who have died. It's also a great act of Christian charity to pray for the forgotten, those who have no one else to pray for them. God knows who they are!

Saint of the Week

St. Sebastian

Feast Day: January 20th

Not much is known about Sebastian's youth other than in 283 he joined the Roman Army, perhaps in order to be of service to Christians who were being persecuted by the Romans. He was promoted to the Praetorian Guard to protect Emperor Diocletian. While serving as Praetorian Guard he converted several people to Christianity, including the local prefect. In 286 he was reported to Diocletian for being a Christian and converting others to Christianity. Diocletian ordered Sebastian to be killed by having

him tied to a stake and used as target practice. Archers riddled his body with arrows and thought him dead. However, a woman, Irene, discovered Sebastian was still living and nursed him back to health. Sebastian searched out Diocletian and publicly criticized him for his persecution of the Christians. Diocletian ordered Sebastian to be beaten to death with clubs. His body was recovered by a Christian woman and she secretly buried him in the catacombs beneath Rome. St. Sebastian is the patron saint of soldiers and athletes.
