Saint of the Week

Saint Thomas Aquinas Feast Day: January 28th

Saint Thomas was born in Italy in 1225. He entered the Order at Naples at age 17, was a disciple of St. Albert the Great, and at age 25 earned the title of "doctor" from the University of Paris. The *Summa Theologiae* is his best-known work, and is one of the most influential works of philosophy and the Church. It was published in 1485. Saint Thomas is the patron saint of Catholic schools and students.

Mother whose hands never cease to serve vour beloved children because they are moved by the divine love and immense mercy that exist in your heart, cast your compassionate eyes upon me and see the snarl of knots that exists in my life. You know very well how desperate I am, my pain, and how I am bound by these knots. Mary, Mother to whom God entrusted the undoing of the knots in the lives of his children, I entrust into your hands the ribbon of my life. No one, not even the evil one himself, can take it away from your precious care. In your hands there is no knot that cannot be undone. Powerful Mother, by your grace and intercessory power with Your Son and My Liberator, Jesus, take into your hands today this knot. In every Catholic Church you will find a *tabernacle*. In our church, the *tabernacle* is located behind the altar. It is gold, box-like, and has a lock.



The word *tabernacle* means "<u>dwelling place</u>."
In the *tabernacle* you will find the Eucharist.
The *tabernacle* is where the Eucharist dwells.
Catholics believe Jesus is truly present in the
Eucharist and it therefore cannot be thrown away, so
it is stored in the *tabernacle* until it is to be used
again at the next Mass or to be distributed to the sick.
To prevent the Eucharist from being removed or
damaged there is a lock on the *tabernacle*. Only
authorized people in the church may open the
tabernacle. Because Jesus is truly present in the
Eucharist and we are to honor the presence of Jesus
in the Eucharist, a *Sanctuary Candle*remains lit near the *tabernacle*.
