



**FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD:** February 2<sup>nd</sup> is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. We recall the event of Jesus being taken to the temple shortly after His birth to fulfill the prescripts of the Jewish Law. Simeon reveals Jesus that day as "a light of revelation to the Gentiles and the glory of His people Israel." The day is

traditionally called "Candlemas Day" because of the blessing of candles during the Liturgy. Candles for use in the home will be blessed at the 8:00 a.m. Mass that day with a limited supply of those candles being available in the back of the church. There are two blessed candles per box and a donation of \$3.00 per box would be appreciated to help defray the cost of the candles. May Christ our light continue to lead us in life.



**ST. BLAISE/BLESSING OF THROATS** is February 3<sup>rd</sup>. St. Blaise's protection of those with throat troubles apparently comes from a legend that a boy was brought to him who had a fishbone stuck in his throat. St. Blaise is also the patron saint of wild animals because of his care for them. You can follow in

his footsteps by supporting and protecting wildlife in your area. Even a birdfeeder can help God's creatures survive. Blessing of throats at our parish will be done as a general blessing at the Masses on the weekend of February 5th and 6th.
