NEXT SUNDAY— FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING: VICTORIOUS OVER SIN AND DEATH

We have become militant in our efforts to recycle, create green space, improve our atmosphere and prevent natural disasters by better understanding weather patterns and causes of severe storms. These things are all good. In fact God gave this as a directive to Adam.... That he was to “rule” over all things and use them for good. We have Earth Day and campaigns to plant and hug trees. We have governmental standards and laws to insure healthier living.

We have also been very diligent in research and development for cures against cancer, heart disease and other life threatening ailments. Much is spent in the way of time and money to assure healthier and longer lives!!! Even McDonald’s is concerned. All well and good.

All in all Death is still a reality of the Fallen nature of Man. All will perish after an extended life upon a planet that is also a passing thing. These efforts allow a false sense of hope in the lives of people so that they do not have to face the real reality: **Sin is the problem....** Not aerosol cans... **Sin is the problem** not cancer... **Sin is the problem** not weather patterns.

THE ANSWER TO SIN IS CHRIST THE KING!

His victory over Death is a victory over sin. His resurrection is the model of the life to come in a new kingdom that is everlasting. He took on flesh to remind us that our human nature is good. Direct the Fight:

- **Jesus directs our fight with Mercy!**

Our temptation is always to fight evil with evil.... An eye for an eye... a tooth for a tooth. But Jesus' mercy softens hearts, redirects passions to a greater good. - **The Sacraments: *Baptism; Eucharist; Confession; Confirmation; Anointing; Marriage and Holy Orders***


The sacraments consecrate us; nurtures us; sustains us; renews us; and directs us with a clear disposition that can avoid sin and be Faithful to the Gospel.

Cash Bash Wrap up—The joint fundraiser proved to be a fun and profitable event for both St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and Immaculate Conception Parishes. The expenses have all

been paid and each parish showed a profit of \$7,477.92. Thank you to our planning committee, to all of our volunteers who helped at the event, and to all who donated water, pop, or an auction basket or who helped in any way — **WE THANK YOU!** It was such a fun event, and one that we hope to have again in 2022.

The Mission Cooperation Plan - Through this program, the Mission Office directs missionaries to visit diocesan parishes once a year to discuss conditions in their countries and seek donations. Hundreds of requests are received, and 31 missionary groups are selected each year.



As a part of the Mission Cooperation Plan the Diocese has assigned IC & Seton the Diocese of Bangued, Philippines. Fr. Alvin Aberion, from Uniontown and

Fr. Rodel from New Kensington, will be offering all our Masses here at Immaculate Conception and at Seton the weekend of November 20/21.

The Diocese of Bangued (Diocese Banguedensis)

The Diocese of Bangued was erected as a Prelature on June 12, 1955. Then on November 15, 1962, it was elevated to Diocese. It comprises the civil province of Abra in the Philippines.

The arrival of the Divine Word Missionaries (SVD) in the Philippines antedates the creation of the Diocese of Bangued. This religious congregation founded by St. Arnold Janssen began their missionary activities in the Philippines with their arrival in Bangued, Abra in 1909.

It was the SVD missionaries who continued the evangelization of Abra from the earlier missionaries who introduced the Christian faith. It was also the Divine Word Missionaries who built the Churches and Catholic Schools in the Diocese. Many of the first SVD missionaries in the Diocese of Bangued came from the United States.

But perhaps what really connects the Diocese of Bangued to the Diocese of Greensburg was the establishment of a minor seminary in 1960 for the formation and training of those who want to be priests. Almost all of the priests of the Diocese of Bangued are products of the minor seminary.

The first Bishop of the Diocese, Bishop Odilo Etspueler, SVD made it his priority to develop the Diocesan Clergy. And thanks to his vision of forming the local clergy, the Diocese of Bangued could share some of her priests to the Diocese of Greensburg many years later.

The first international priest from the Diocese of Bangued, Fr. Efen Ambre who completed five years of service in the Diocese of Greensburg is a happy fruit of this minor seminary. Those who came after Fr. Ambre, Fr. Rodel Molina, Fr. Alvin Aberion and Fr. Liberato Ortega are also products of the St. Joseph Minor Seminary in the Diocese of Bangued.

Whatever donation you will give to the mission appeal of the Diocese of Bangued will help in the continued formation of the seminarians in the Diocese of Bangued and who knows one day the Diocese of Greensburg will once again reap the fruits of your generosity when in the future the Diocese of Bangued will continue to share its priests to the International Priests program of the Diocese of Greensburg.

Thank you in advance for your kind donations to the Diocese of Bangued through this mission appeal and we pray that you and your families will be abundantly blessed by God.
