## **GOSPEL— Mark 1:40-45**

A leper came to Jesus and kneeling down begged him and said, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. Then, warning him sternly, he dismissed him at once.

He said to him, "See that you tell no one anything, but go, show yourself to the priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses prescribed; that will be proof for them."

# DO YOU KNOW THE MAGIC RATIO 5:1 IN MARRIAGE?



The Gottman Institute, a research hub dedicated to helping couples experience thriving relationships, discovered a Magic Ratio for marriage success. All couples disagree, argue and fight, but it's important to know how to communicate effectively in those moments.

Dr. Gottman says the success of marriage depends on it. He found that in conflict conversations, successful couples needed *five seconds* of time together in a positive (or neutral) emotional state for every *one second* in a negative emotional state. **Marriage has a magic ratio of 5:1**, meaning that for every negative comment/reaction, it takes five positive interactions to balance out the psychological effect of the one negative. Having a ratio below **5:1** within conflict became one of the many potential divorce indicators found in Gottman's research.

When couples re-tell their love story—how they met, fell in love and their proposal—research shows the brainwaves trigger the bonding mechanism within the brain, linking spouses physically and emotionally together in a positive light.

Take advantage of the **5:1** ratio in marriage. Outweigh negative encounters with positive and let the magic happen!

# CONCRETE REALITIES

**O**ur second reading this week rounds out St. Paul's wider discussion in *1 Corinthians chapters 8-10* that centers on not giving offense. He encourages followers of Jesus to subordinate Christian liberty to Christian love. Before he moves on to address issues related to the liturgy in *chapters 11-14*, he summarizes this section with encouragement to do everything for the glory of God as Paul himself does. Since this weekend is *World Marriage Sunday*, we will consider this reading from the standpoint of marriage and family life.

"Whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God." That strikes me as the mantra for the calling to marriage and family life.

St. John Paul II expounded on this same theme when he wrote on *The Role of the Christian Family in the Modern World*:



***"The sacrament of marriage is the specific source and original means of sanctification for Christian married couples and families. It takes up again and makes specific the sanctifying grace of Baptism. [...] Christian spouses and parents are included in the universal call to sanctity. For them this call is specified by the sacrament they have celebrated and is carried out concretely in the realities proper to their conjugal and family life. This gives rise to the grace and requirement of an authentic and profound conjugal and family spirituality [...] Christian marriage ... is in itself a liturgical action glorifying God in Jesus Christ and in the Church."*** (no. 56)

# saint VALENTINE

There's not too much that is known about St. Valentine. In fact, a quick search reveals that there are *three* St. Valentines who compete for patron of this day. The only thing they have in common is that they all were martyrs. It is their love for Christ and the time of year (bird mating season) that are the only documented ties relating to our current understanding of Valentine's Day. And for the most part, St. Valentine's day has been usurped by *Hallmark*, florists and school parties.

For me, St. Valentine's Day is so much more. I grew up at St. Valentine's Parish. I went to school and had all my Sacraments there—my kids received some of their Sacraments there too. It was there at Adoration, praying for the son in my belly, that it was decided his middle name would be Valentine.

St. Valentine is the patron saint of lovers. Lovers are *intimate, known, and claimed*, a desire God has placed on every human heart. It is more than physical; it is being vulnerable and sharing your secret hopes and wounds. It is praying together and planning for eternity. Lovers lead to families where being *intimate, known and claimed* is grown and repeated until time ends. St. Valentine is a reminder of who God is and who we are.

Our family's tradition on St. Valentine's Day is to celebrate the love and memories we had the year before. We do this by printing out all our pictures from the previous year and making photo albums and a 2020 collage for our wall. As our collections of collages grow, it is evident how many blessing God has poured down on us, but most importantly it is a reminder that we are known and loved.







# RETREAT

Throughout the Gospels we see that Jesus frequently takes time to retreat from His daily world. He heads to the mountains, goes out to the desert, or climbs into a boat to cross to another shore. He feels the need to get away from the crowds, and probably also from His rag-tag bunch of disciples, and spend intentional time alone, in silence, with the Father.

How often do we yearn for this one-on-one time with the Lord; to take some time away from the busyness, the distractions, and the anxieties of the world around us? We are blessed to have the opportunity to do so in daily doses through Eucharistic Adoration at our parishes. But have you ever wanted to go deeper, spending a whole day or a whole weekend dedicated to building your relationship with God?

One way to build this relationship is by participating in a retreat. If you've gone on a retreat in the past, you know that it can be an enlightening, refreshing, and profound experience. If you've never considered going on a retreat, don't be shy or intimidated by the thought. You don't have to have a certain level of holiness or theological knowledge to participate. If you open your heart to God, He is happy to meet you wherever you are and provide for you the graces that you seek.

But it's hard, isn't it? We have family responsibilities, work commitments, things we have to get done on the weekends.

If you're married, consider this: Can you shoulder these responsibilities for one weekend so that your spouse can go on retreat and grow closer to the Lord? Or can you ask your spouse to do this for you, so that your relationship with God can be strengthened? It's *World Marriage Sunday*—the perfect time to ask!

If you're single: Can you put aside your responsibilities, or ask a sibling or friend to help with them, so you can grow closer to the Lord? Or is there someone in your life for whom you could do the same?
