#### An email from our diocese:

As a follow-up to last week's change in COVID policy, with the reimplementation of a diocesan-wide mask mandate, pastors and parish leaders are reminded that masks should be worn not only when entering and exiting churches and worship spaces, but throughout the duration of the liturgy, even when seated. While we want to build places of worship that foster the welcome of all, particularly at this beautiful time of year, part of our pastoral outreach in this extraordinary time should be to ensure the safety of all of our congregants.

To that end, please take the following three-point approach in all worship settings:

- post signage that states that masks are required at all times
- ask ushers and ministers of hospitality to provide reminders as people enter to wear their mask
- make an announcement before each liturgy thanking individuals for complying with the mask mandate

  New York State has said that non-compliance can carry with it a \$1000 fine for individuals and/or businesses/organizations.

#### The Nativity of the Lord

"He so loved us that for our sake He was made man in time, through Whom all times were made; was in the world less in years than His servants, though older than the world itself in His eternity; was made man, Who made man; was created of a mother, whom He created; was carried by hands which He formed; nursed at the breasts which He had filled; cried in the manger in wordless infancy, He the Word without Whom all human eloquence is mute (St. Augustine, Sermon 188)." The miracle of what happens at Christmas is truly an awesome mystery. Revealed in the silent ordinariness of life is God's intimate love for humanity and all that he made. The Word, existing for all time, comes and dwells among us. God kisses us. We can seek and soar with playful delight as a joy never known before fills our heart.

Throw caution to the wind and go with God. We have been blessed with talents, gifts, and life eternal. Follow the rhythm of the dance with joy and listen to what the Word who became flesh tells us about what the next steps can be. Today, heaven remains the same, but earth has been profoundly changed.
