



Faith Moment Reflection

An old African folk tale that speaks of three blind men who examine an elephant to try to determine what sort of animal it might be goes like this: One grabs hold of the elephant's tail and exclaims, "This creature is very like a rope." The second man runs his hand over one of the tusks, declaring, "This creature is very like a spear." Finally, the third man, patting the wide, solid side of the elephant, says, "This creature is surely a wall."

Individually, each of the blind men grasped *an aspect* of the majestic creature, but their understanding was limited. But, by sharing their insights, they were given an understanding of elephants that none of them could have alone.

Like the experience of those three men, all of the Church's various celebrations throughout the year work together to help us enter more deeply into the mysteries of salvation and the ways that God has been—and continues to be—at work in the world. This Sunday's celebration honoring the Most Holy Trinity is no exception.

As we draw closer to God and the mystery of the Trinity, we learn about God's love. God has lavished us with love in the persons of the Son and the Spirit, who in turn nurture in us the desire to do the same. When we open ourselves to be filled with an awareness of the divine life within us, we participate in the endless spiral of love that leads to eternal life. Whenever we share selfless love in the family, we are sharing in the life of the Trinity.
