Church Announcement Regarding SEAS Mailing

As many of you know, during the Diocese's Road to Renewal process, it was originally recommended that St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (SEAS) Parish be closed and its members merged into Holy Trinity Parish.

After our parish family asked the Diocese to reconsider, a new decision was made: SEAS will close as a parish, but the church building will remain open as a worship site of Holy Trinity.

A mailing was recently sent to all active registered parishioners of SEAS explaining this change.

Beginning June 9th, Holy Trinity will officially assume all financial and administrative responsibilities for SEAS, and the SEAS site will continue to be used for worship.

What does this mean for you as a current SEAS member? Very little will change in your day-to-day parish life:

- ☐ The SEAS church building will remain open.
- ☐ Both Mass times will stay the same.
- ☐ If you would like to continue worshipping primarily at the SEAS worship site, simply check off Holy Trinity as your new parish on the form provided.
- ☐ You will begin receiving offertory envelopes under Holy Trinity, which is now responsible for supporting and maintaining the SEAS buildings. Please return the form included in the transitional envelopes provided in the mailing.

If you no longer wish to worship at SEAS or Holy Trinity, you may select another parish within The Lord's Vineyard family or a parish outside of it. Important Reminders:

- ☐ The diocese will not allow us to automatically transfer your membership frm SEAS to Holy Trinity, or any other parish, without your consent. If you do not return the form or select a new parish, you will no longer be considered a registered parishioner anywhere. This is not recommended, as parish registration is essential for receiving the sacraments, sacramental preparation, and staying connected to the Church community.
- ☐ If you would like to continue worshipping primarily at the SEAS worship site, please make any offertory checks payable to Holy Trinity. Do not make checks out to SEAS, as it will no longer exist as a parish entity.

We thank you for your continued faith and presence as we move forward together as one family in Christ.
