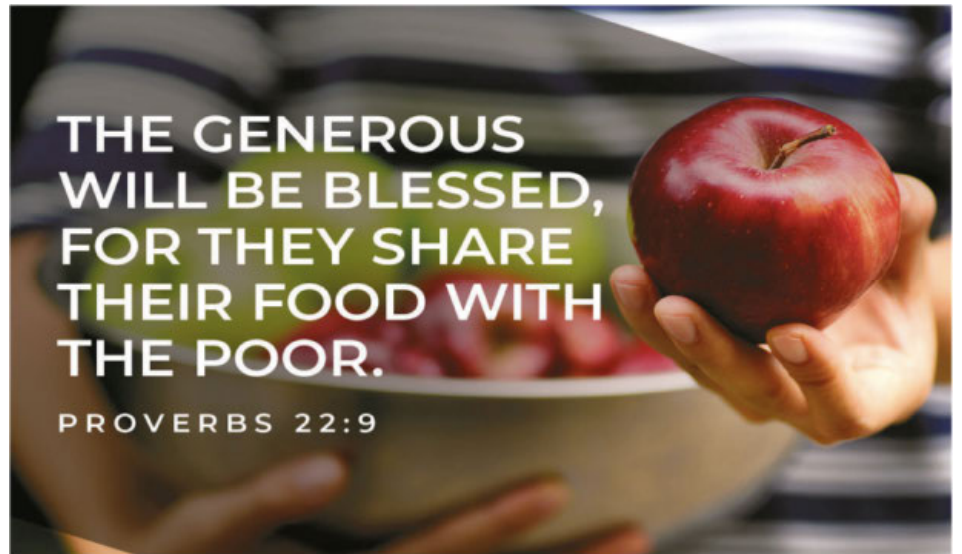
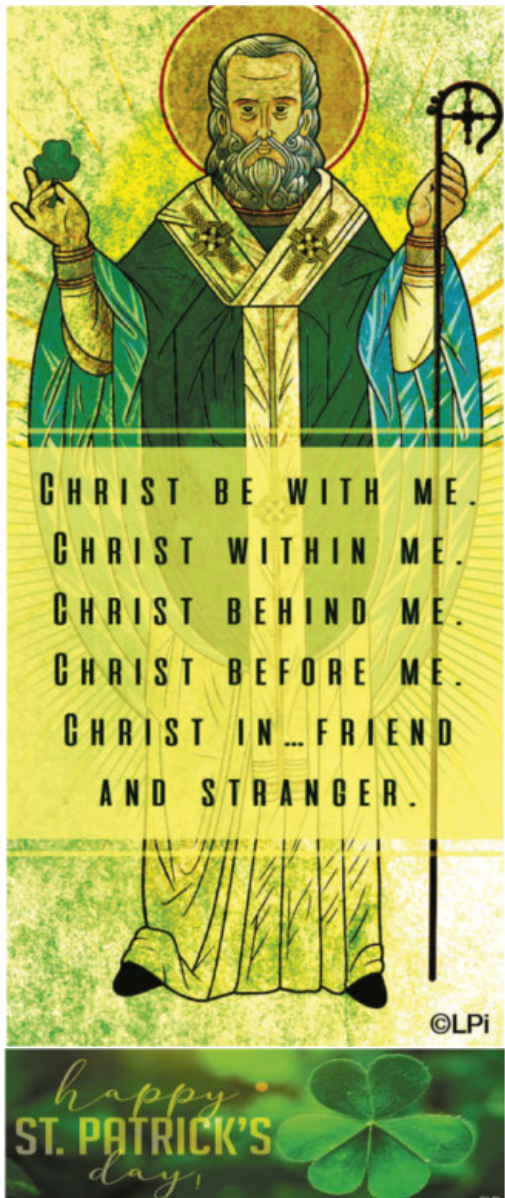

Pastor's Letter

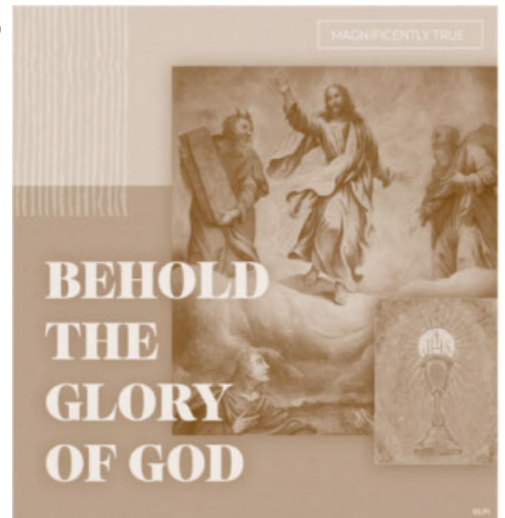
Mark, My Words:

Waiting, waiting, waiting. How much of your life is spent waiting with anxiety for test results... or to hear a teenager's key in the door at night... or in a slow line at the supermarket. The frustration about most waiting seems to be simply the not knowing.

Today, the apostles see sights and sounds which they can't understand: Jesus, Moses, and Elijah are being brilliantly transformed in glory on the mountain top—and the real waiting is just beginning! Jesus will die and be taken from them. They cannot live in the constant glory of the mountain top—and neither can we.

We know that our life purpose is to have a deep, life-changing relationship of love with God. But if we have not had a "mountain top experience" with Jesus, we may feel that the waiting is getting old. Where does this leave us? First, we make a very human mistake in thinking that we have NOT seen Jesus in his glory. It's just that the mountain-top we were on with Jesus might have been a hospital delivery room where we gave birth or watched our baby being born. Or perhaps in a bedroom where we witnessed the blessed death of a "good and faithful servant" whom we will love forever.

We do not have to see God Almighty with human eyes to know God's glory is with us. Sometimes God's glory comes to us as God's Mystery. When we touch the Mystery of life, death, birth, suffering, healing... God's glory is there.

The Woman They Could Not Silence by Kate Moore will be reviewed by the Book Discussion Group on **March 14, 2022**. Victorian housewife and mother of six, Elizabeth Packard, attended a Woman's Rights Convention in 1848 which inspired her to want more freedoms. She began voicing her opinions on politics and religion. Her husband did not share her beliefs and felt threatened. He therefore had her committed to the Illinois State Hospital because he declared her "slightly insane". She found other women at the hospital who were also incarcerated by their husbands. Her writings and other efforts made a giant leap in human rights. Meetings are the second Monday of the month from 10:00am until noon in the Family Life Center at STM Church. All are welcome.

The Lectionary Study Group (Tuesday mornings at SJC) will be offering a special online book study for Lent/Easter: *Dining in the Kingdom of God – the Origins of the Eucharist in the Gospel of Luke* by Fr. Eugene LaVerdiere, SSS.

Fr. LaVerdiere was a highly respected New Testament scholar. The author of many books, he taught at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago and Mundelein Seminary. The book is most appropriate this season: our Sunday Lectionary centers on the Gospel of Luke, the U.S. bishops are currently working on a statement on the Eucharist and one of the foci of the Vatican's Synod is to reflect on what it truly means to be in communion.

It is tested by whether we practice in life what our faith teaches us. We must always remember what Jesus said. "You are my friends if you do what I command you" (Jn. 15:14). The Eucharist helps love to triumph in us--love over hatred, zeal over indifference.

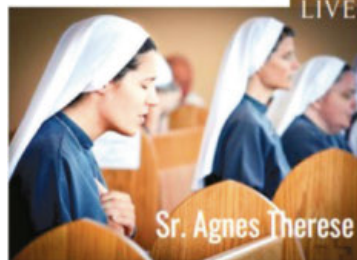

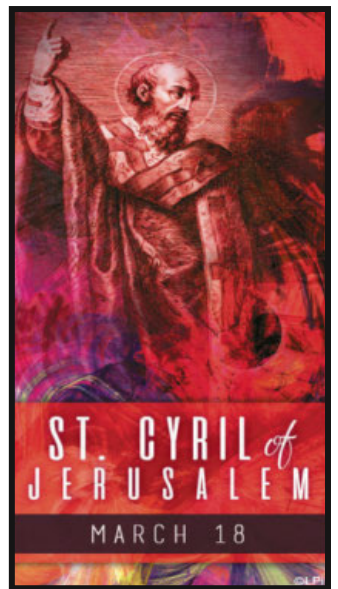
