



LIVE THE LITURGY Inspiration for the week

Many people give their allegiance to something until it requires them to do something challenging or radical. Then, they find themselves rethinking whether they want to be associated with it. The same holds for God. Either we serve God, or we don't. There can be no lukewarm stance with regard to faith.

If we are in, then faith in Jesus Christ asks us to do some difficult things: work in service of God's kingdom, love our enemies, offer no resistance to injury, and trust that the Eucharist is in fact Jesus' very Body and Blood. For some, buying into these things may prove too difficult and a return to a life without them is preferred. But truth is truth and it can only be found in God.

If we find it hard to accept it from the mouth of Christ, where else can we go to find it? The task before us is to commit to the truth even when it may be easier to pursue something else. Truth is always worth obtaining even when it is difficult. Jesus offers us the truth of life, a life found in his own flesh and blood and a life of discipleship.

THERE IS SOMETHING SPECIAL IN OUR PARISH – CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD



Level I Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is offered to children ages 3-6 years old. Parish families can register their child for either the Tuesday afternoon program, 2:00 PM-3:15 PM or the Thursday morning program, 11:00 AM-12:15 PM. Children visit the atrium once a week and are given individual presentations with sensorial materials. They are then free to work independently in the specially prepared atrium environment. The focus in Level I is God as our Good Shepherd. At the end of class, we come together as a group at the prayer table for prayer and song. CGS works through a three year cycle; each year the child is introduced to new materials, or deeper lessons on information they are already familiar with.

Level II CGS is offered to children ages 6-9 (Grades 1-3) on either Wednesday, 4:30 PM-5:45 PM or Thursday, 6:00 PM-7:15 PM. The children spend time in the atrium session once a week. Their presentations are given either individually or in small

groups. The materials are available to work with however, they are also encouraged to work independently or in small groups to explore each

lesson on a deeper level. The presentations in Level II center on God as the True Vine. Again, level II is arranged in a three year cycle of lessons, so each year offers new lessons and new materials. This is an alternative to Traditional CCD.

WOMEN'S GUILD

Originally, the St. Valentine Women's Club, now known as the Our Lady of Hope Women's Guild, was organized in February of 1950 with the purpose of raising funds to build a parish school. As the years progressed the group wanted to be more than a fund-raising source. They sought enrollment in the Arch-Confraternity of Christian

Mother's and became known at St. Valentine Women's Club/Christian Mothers.

Today, with the merger of four churches, the group realizes they are like any "organic group" evolving and growing into the future with a stronger need to redefine who they are. They are no longer just a group of married women with children; the group includes women pursuing careers, single moms working to support their families, married women with and without children, grandmothers, and widows with "village wisdom" to share.

Meetings are run from September through May and are usually held the third Thursday of each month in Frawley Hall, unless otherwise advertised in the bulletin. Meetings begin with the recitation of the Holy Rosary, a brief meeting, and a speaker. We adjourn for some time of fellowship, food, and wine.
