

“Transformation: Our Lenten Pilgrimage of Hope”

St. Joseph Parish in Florence is hosting a Two-Part Lenten Mission with Deacon Rick DiGiorgio of Prince of Peace Parish in Hoover, AL.

As we continue to follow Pope Francis' call to HOPE in this special Jubilee Year, Deacon Rick shares the Kerygma (the core message of the Gospel) which leads us to a personal relationship with Jesus that changes everything about how we understand life and the world around us. Through our Baptism, the Holy Spirit empowers us to know and understand what it means to love our neighbor as we are transformed by God's loving plan that is "ANCHORED IN HOPE" (Hebrews 6:19)!

A short 15-minute period of Eucharistic Adoration will follow each talk in the Church with Benediction.

From Fr. Jonathan

**There are three components to lent: Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. We cannot have a fruitful lent while neglecting one of these three essential parts of this season. Here at Saint Joseph we are doing what we can to help you enter into these holy days.**

1. Prayer: take advantage of the various things we will be offering during lent especially the stations of the cross, the parish mission, time of adoration and Holy Week. Without increased devotion to the Lord, fasting and almsgiving don't make sense.

2. Fasting: This is something more personal obviously, but you will want to at least do the bare minimum that the Church requires: Giving up meat on Fridays and fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. It's a wonderful tradition to give up other things for the entire period: especially things that we are attached to or are not good for us.

3. Almsgiving. Traditionally the money that we save by fasting we offer for the poor. This year we will be joining forces with St. Joseph school to raise money for the passing on of the faith in Communist Cuba. Catholic education is illegal, and the parishes are limited by having almost no resources. I'm working directly with the diocese of Santa Clara where I know the bishop and some of the priests. Please be generous with the rice bowls.

4. May the Lord bless us and all with the gifts of joy and peace during these holy days.



## PALABRAS DEL PADRE:


Hay tres aspectos importantes de la Cuaresma: la oración, el ayuno y la limosna. No podemos tener una Cuaresma fructífera si descuidamos una de estas tres partes esenciales de esta temporada. Aquí en San José estamos haciendo lo que podemos para ayudarte a entrar en estos días santos.

1. Oración: aprovecha las diversas cosas que ofreceremos durante la Cuaresma, especialmente el Vía Crucis, los momentos de adoración y la Semana Santa. Sin una mayor devoción al Señor, el ayuno y la limosna no tienen sentido.

2. Ayuno: esto es algo más personal, obviamente, pero querrás al menos hacer el mínimo que requiere la Iglesia: dejar de comer carne los viernes y ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. Es una tradición maravillosa renunciar a otras cosas durante todo el período: especialmente a las cosas a las que estamos apegados o que no son buenas para nosotros.

3. Limosna. Tradicionalmente, el dinero que ahorraremos ayunando lo ofrecemos a los pobres. Este año vamos a unir fuerzas con la escuela San José para recaudar fondos para la transmisión de la fe en la Cuba comunista. La educación católica es ilegal y las parroquias están limitadas por no tener casi recursos. Estoy trabajando directamente con la diócesis de Santa Clara, donde conozco al obispo y a algunos de los sacerdotes. Por favor, sean generosos.

4. Que el Señor nos bendiga a nosotros y a todos con los dones de la alegría y la paz durante estos días santos.
