#### A Letter From Our Pastor

#### **Dear Friends:**

I am the light of the world; he who follows me will not walk in darkness. The Lord gives light to the blind. Brethren, that light shines on us now, for we have had our eyes anointed with the eye-salve of faith. His saliva was mixed with earth to anoint the man born blind. We are of Adam's stock, blind from our birth; we need him to give us light.

Saint Augustine

Our eyesight is a precious gift. But even more important is the vision that comes from faith.

In the Gospel of John, Jesus heals a man born blind, then leads that man to the deeper vision that comes from faith. His story is our story: we were born spiritually blind, as St. Augustine says, as a result of Original Sin. At baptism we are washed and anointed; and we receive the gift of faith that enables us to have insight that comes from God. We need to continually grow in that vision of faith, so that we can more clearly know and love Jesus. May our Lenten journey open our eyes of faith to see more clearly God's love for us and see more clearly how we can share that love with all those we encounter each day.
