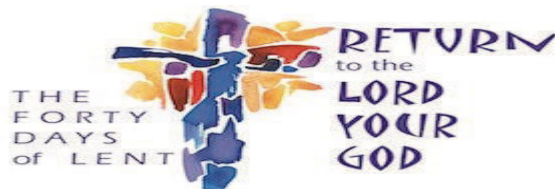

A Letter From Our Pastor

Dear Friends:

*Were you there when they crucified my Lord?
Were you there when they crucified my Lord?
Oh! sometimes it causes me to tremble, tremble, tremble.
Were you there when they crucified my Lord?*

This beautiful African-American spiritual hymn, captures perfectly what the liturgy is all about. The hymn relates how the worshippers feel when they think about the Passion of the Lord. When we celebrate the liturgies of the Church, especially the Mass, we are there where the Lord was crucified. We are at the Last Supper when He signified what His death meant and where He instituted the Eucharist that makes us present to His sacrifice and where we commune with our Risen Lord.

This is true of every Mass, but the Liturgies of Holy Week help us to experience this in a powerful way. We spend time reflecting on the Lord's entrance into Jerusalem, the Lord humbly washing the feet of His disciples, the institution of the Eucharist in the Upper Room: with a joyful solemnity celebrating His presence with us in the Blessed Sacrament. We watch with Him in the Garden of Gethsemane. We hear again the story of His Passion proclaimed in a dramatic way. We begin in the shadows of the tomb, then experience the light of the Risen Christ.

We are there when we worship and, like those who gave us the hymn "Were You There," our worship is meant to help us understand the meaning of our lives in the light of Christ. May this Holy Week strengthen our faith, re-ignite our love for worship and illuminate our daily paths.

We will celebrate only one service each of the "Three Days" the Triduum, to emphasize our oneness as a parish family. We hope you can attend as much as possible during this Holy Week. There will be Stations of the Cross on Good Friday Evening also for those who cannot attend the service during the day.

We must return all printed copies by April 15th to the Catholic Leadership Institute. Thanks to all of you who have taken part already; we have had a tremendous response!

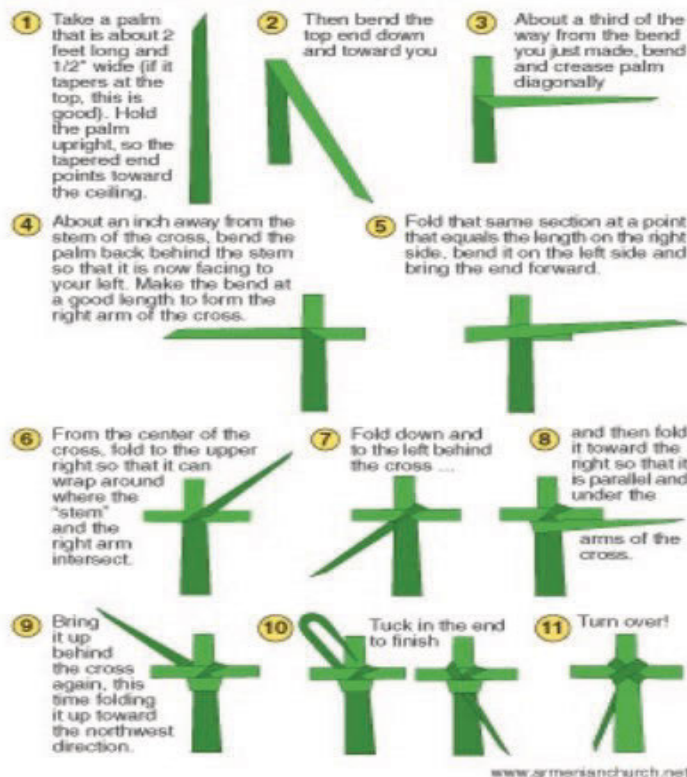

- **THINK PRAYER.** If you have to work or go to school during Holy Week, think about how you can incorporate prayer breaks into each day.
- **MAKE AN ADDITIONAL SACRIFICE** by fasting and abstaining from meat on Holy Thursday and Holy Saturday in addition to Good Friday.
- **DON'T WATCH TELEVISION** from sundown on Holy Thursday until Easter morning.
- **GO** to confession.
- **SET ASIDE** 10 minutes every day to read Passion accounts in the Gospels.
- Make it a point to **FORGIVE** someone on Good Friday.
- **PRAY** the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary.
- **OFFER UP** any pain or difficulties you experience during Holy Week and unite your sufferings with the pain of Christ.
- **PRAY** the Stations of the Cross.
- **ATTEND** all of the Triduum liturgies.
- **INVITE** family members, friends, and neighbors — especially people who have strayed from the church — to come to church with you.

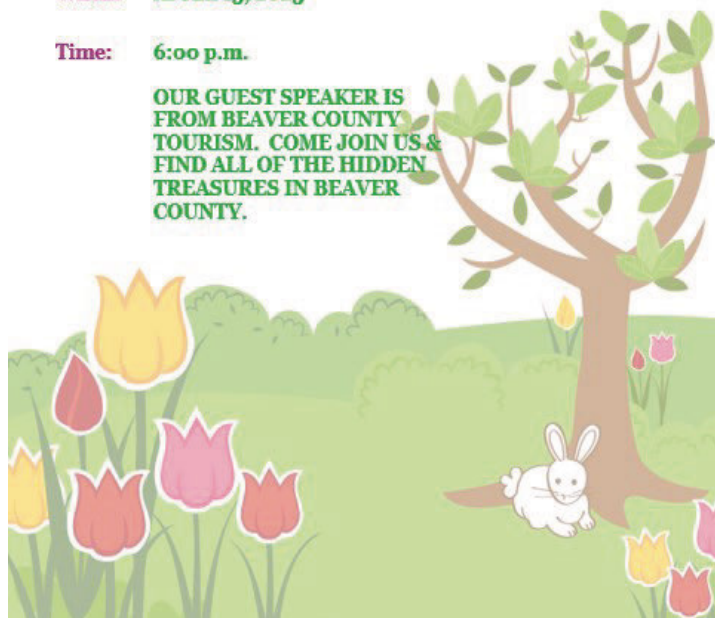

Sacred Triduum

The word "Triduum" comes from the Latin word meaning "three days," and encompasses the three most sacred days in the Church year. It begins at sundown on Holy Thursday, reaches a high point at the Easter Vigil, and concludes with evening prayer at sundown on Easter Sunday. The liturgical celebrations during the Triduum on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday are rich with symbolism and flow from one to another in a seamless way. While it may appear as if these liturgies are separate and distinct, they are actually intended to be one continuous celebration that commemorates the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. For this reason, Catholics are encouraged to observe the entire Triduum by attending all of the liturgies.
