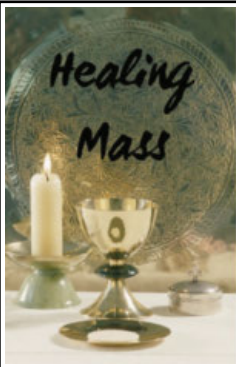
After looking at our parish ministry groups and assessing potential needs, we are hoping to form a new group to personally reach out to those in our parish who are recently grieving the loss of a loved one.

"I WAS TIRED OF LIVING IN PAIN..."

Fibromyalgia affects the entire body, and even more complicated, it affects everyone's body a little differently. Symptoms are difficult

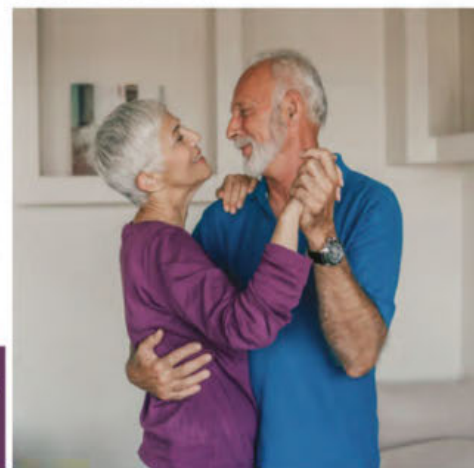
to predict and often change on a daily basis. Some days you're plagued with widespread muscle pain and fatigue, other days it's a headache or sensitivity to touch.
