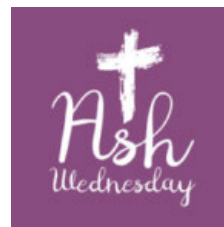




### Mardi Gras Dance

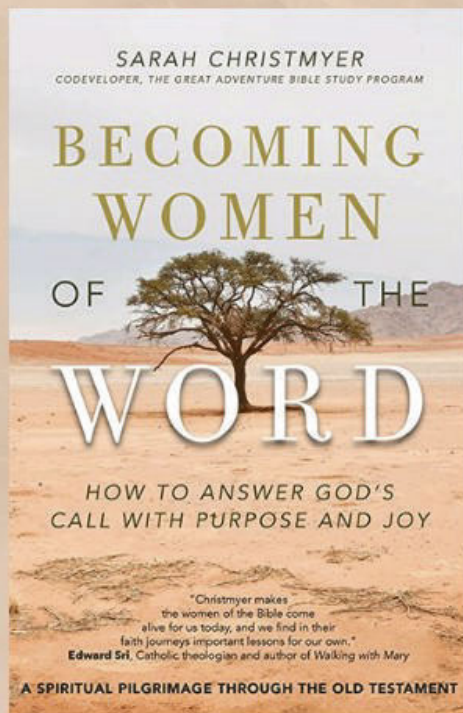

### A Lenten Meditation on Lent (2)

In Laudato Si', Pope Francis calls us to live more simply. What can this short phrase or prayer mean to those of us who have been so showered with abundance in our lives? "People may well have a growing ecological sensitivity but it has not succeeded in changing their harmful habits of consumption which, rather than decreasing, appear to be growing all the more. A simple example is the increasing use and power of air-conditioning" [LS 55]. The term "overconsumption" may bring to mind shopping bags and large houses with overflowing closets, but more accurately, it is our common and pervasive use of energy that harms the earth through pollution and emissions, and creates wide gaps between global haves and have-nots ([ourworldindata.org](http://ourworldindata.org)). As we begin our journey through Lent, let us seek to live more simply to lessen the strain on the earth's resources and its ability for renewal.

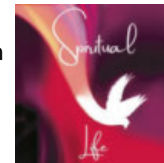
