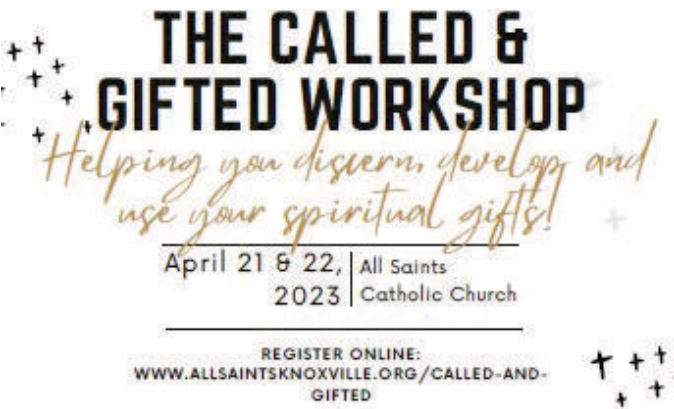

A Lenten Meditation for Our Earth

(Adapted from "52 WAYS TO CARE FOR CREATION" from the Laudato Si' Movement)
Adoption of Sustainable Lifestyles According to Dr. Vincent Miller, Professor of Theology at the University of Dayton, Ohio, the word "lifestyle" appears in Pope Francis' Laudato Si encyclical 17 times. He has described how every physical item we possess has a connection to land, labor, and life itself. We would do well to develop an attitude of "serene awareness" when purchasing, and question a manufacturer's production methods and waste policies. "Everything is connected" [LS 91] and globally, the environment and poor people are increasingly paying the price for our commodities. Free shipping is not really free! One of the seven major goals of the Laudato Si Movement is the Adoption of Sustainable Lifestyles- an invitation to exhibit sobriety when consuming resources and using energy. Old dogs can learn new tricks, and Lent is a perfect time to re-evaluate and re-invent our own lifestyles!

Give Thanks for the Sacrament and Commitment of Matrimony!

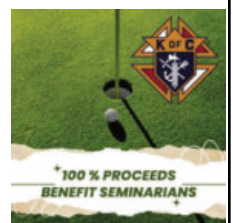

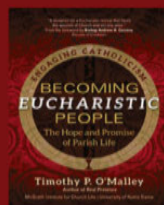
