My Sisters and Brothers,

**The Fourth of July!!** Please don't tell me that Summer is half over. It seems like it is just getting going. The truth is, I am just returning from vacation, so my batteries are re-charged, and I am hopefully good for another year. Nevertheless, I hope the remaining days of Summer are filled with times to rest, relax, have fun, and experience sunshine and life-renewing days. This weekend, our nation celebrates our independence and the birth of our country. Let us start with genuine gratitude for who we are and the great country that we belong to. Freedom comes at a great cost, so let us never take that for granted. Lasting peace can only come from justice, and how people's rights are safeguarded, and our commitment to live with a spirit of unity and genuine care for others. So, enjoy the holiday, but appreciate the gift of freedom and peace, and renew your own commitment and effort to preserve the ideals upon which our country was founded, and what it means to insure "liberty and justice for all". Because the actual 4<sup>th</sup> falls on a Sunday this year, the holiday is observed also on Monday, July 5<sup>th</sup>. We will celebrate one Mass at 9:00 am, and the Parish Office will be closed Monday. Happy 4<sup>th</sup>—and 5<sup>th</sup>.

In our Gospel this weekend, Jesus comes home to his own native place. Unfortunately, many who thought they knew Him, took Him for granted and didn't seem to give Him much attention or respect. That prompted Him to observe to the people, "A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house". I feel a little uneasy on how that may be the case with us, or even worse, with myself. I truly believe that each person in our community is unique, gifted and called. We are the baptized Body of Christ. My prayer is that all of us, myself included, would never take anyone for granted, or not be open to how God may choose to work or speak through that person. Obviously, the Lord never meant for the Church to be a chaotic free-for-all. We do have a vision—*Being CHRIST~Every Day~Everywhere*—and that is always the direction we are looking and heading toward. We have a mission—the mission of Jesus—to form true disciples who proclaim the Gospel to every person. We need every person to do his or her part, because "many though we are, we are one Body, one Body in Christ". So, perhaps this important lesson challenges us to take a new look at one another and see the presence of Christ that we could possibly have missed. Even more disturbing is the possibility that we could take for granted the very presence of Jesus—in the Eucharist, in His Word, in His Body, the Church. Let's face it, these are all areas that we are rather comfortable with. Let us never become so comfortable that we are not fully aware and in awe that Jesus is in our midst and truly present in us and among us.

This Saturday evening at the 5:00 Mass, we gather to give thanks with **Fr. Joe** for his three years of service here at St. Gabriel, and to offer him our prayerful support as he begins his new ministry as Administrator of St. Edward Parish in Parkman, and St. Lucy Parish in Middlefield. When Fr. Joe first spoke with me about whether to apply for this opening, my advice to him was to pray (knowing that he is a very holy man of deep prayer), and leave it up to the Holy Spirit. That is exactly what he did. There is a process the diocese has

with all who apply for a parish that includes an interview, prayerful discernment, the decision of the bishop, and ultimately the acceptance of the applicant. After Fr. Joe did these things, he now relies on the Spirit to guide him to take these first steps in this new position and responsibility in our diocese. I know he relies on our prayers and will continue to allow the Spirit to give him what he needs. So, we celebrate his ministry. We bid him farewell here. But, we keep him in our hearts with fond memories and ongoing prayers. Certainly, a card or visit or prayer down the road would always bring him joy. He is a great man and a great priest. I will really miss him, and I know many will.

As Summer fun continues, we as a parish have a couple big events we invite you to join us for, or if possible, give us your support. The first, in three weeks, is our annual **Links Fore Catholic Education** golf event that takes place on Monday, July 26<sup>th</sup> at the incredibly beautiful Mayfield Sand Ridge Golf Club. It is so rightly billed as, "**World class golf while supporting Catholic education**". The proceeds from this event go a long way to assist families in need to afford the priceless gift of a Catholic education. 

## LITURGY CORNER

In this weekend’s readings, we hear of people who hear God’s Word, but for one reason or another, don’t accept it. In the First Reading, the prophet Ezekiel is sent by God to preach to those who are “hard of face and obstinate of heart.” In the Gospel, Mark tells us about Jesus preaching in the synagogue, but those who hear Him question Him and take offense at what He says. It’s timely to hear these readings this weekend when we are celebrating our nation’s birthday and the freedoms we have. By nature, God made us free and gave us free will. In our country, our Constitution guarantees our freedom and gives us the ability to freely practice our faith. But how often do we take our freedom for granted and become “hard of face and obstinate of heart” because of it? How often do we have our own preconceived notion of what our lives should be like and, in spite of what we hear Jesus preach, we choose not to do as He says, but to live as we choose? Let us use our freedom to embrace the teachings of Jesus and as His disciples, share His good news with those we meet.

Since the Fourth of July falls on a Sunday this year, we will be having our special Fourth of July Mass at 9am Monday, July 5<sup>th</sup>. Please come and thank God for the blessings He’s given us in this country where we can freely express ourselves and live out our faith.



The paper recycling bins are provided by St. Gabriel as a courtesy service to our parishioners to recycle household paper. The church does not receive any money for this service. These bins are intended for household paper recycling, not commercial or business recycling. If you, or someone you know, is using our bins for commercial or appliance cardboard recycling, please stop, or ask them to stop. The large amounts of commercial cardboard are filling the bins quickly, preventing our parishioners from using them as intended.

If you have cardboard to recycle, please cut it into flat pieces not more than 15" per side, and tied into neat bundles with string, so that it will lay flat in the bins, leaving space for others. Place this cardboard into the bins labelled for cardboard.

If you come to recycle paper or cardboard and the bins are full, please try again another day. The bins are emptied twice a week. Please do not overfill the bins, leave the large lids up, or place paper or cardboard on the ground around the bins. These actions result in paper and cardboard blowing around the grounds and into neighboring yards. We strive to be good neighbors and keep our grounds clean. Your efforts in assisting us are greatly appreciated.


