My Sisters and Brothers,

Just before school began, we had a very special time with all our new students, especially those transferring from other schools. I am very happy and grateful that we had more new students than ever, and that our enrollment for this year is significantly up. God is good and is doing great things through the love and dedication of our entire faculty, staff and everyone who is a part of our school community. I was asked to say a few words to our newest students, and I told them that I wanted to speak with them about the rules. I said that with a rather stern look and voice and they responded likewise. Right after that introduction, I smiled and reminded them that rules are a good thing for us. They help us to get along, to have order, and to accomplish wonderful things together. Actually, I think deep down they knew and believed that. I told them about a book I had read written by a high-up Disney executive entitled *The Customer Rules*. The thrust of the book was rather obvious. What was most interesting to me was that it was so easy and valuable to apply to just about any area of our lives—including parish and school. The thirty-three “rules” were filled with great wisdom, practical value, and common decency. When the author was finished with the draft of his book, he wanted to write a preface, so he asked his young little daughter what she thought the most important “rule” was. Before I told the new students the answer, I asked them what they thought it was. They nailed it (and I felt so good about that). They said the most important rule is **BE NICE**. After I commended them for being right on, I reminded them that Jesus is the one who gives that rule. Often, like the Pharisees in the Gospel, we get hung up on so many trivial and unimportant matters, that we lose sight of what is ultimately important. I’m not saying there isn’t a place for all sorts of other rules, or that we should ignore them or just pick and choose. What I am saying is that if we are NICE to one another, “Love one another as I love you”, the rest really don’t become major issues. Jesus told the Pharisees, *“This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines human precepts”*.

The first day of school here at St. Gabriel, this past Monday, was absolutely amazing. It started actually on Sunday after the 11:30 Mass at which we blessed all students and teachers. Afterwards, they came over to school to set things up and prepare for their first full day. Our school building was immaculate, welcoming, joyful, and definitely faith-centered. “Everything speaks” (another important Disney principle), and the environment of our school spoke volumes about how much people care to give our children the very best. There was so much joy and excitement in both the parents and the students, as well as our fantastic faculty and staff. What a blessing. Then, on Monday morning, out on the parking lot—hundreds of cars and school buses bringing anxious students to begin a new year came in so orderly and cooperatively. Thanks to our fantastic maintenance crew who were all out there with their smiles of welcome and their guidance for safety. The most amazing part was that as soon as the opening bell rang and we began with prayer, the teachers and students were truly “at it”. You could hear a pin drop. Students were immediately engaged in learning and growing, and there was a spirit of joy and togetherness you could feel without a doubt. I believe that initial experience carries through and has a lasting effect. Don’t get

me wrong, we will certainly have “those days”. However, because of who we are—and I mean the people we are—we will not only deal with those days and times, but we will become even better and stronger. The saying “it takes a village”, for us means, “it takes a community”. I want you to know that means all of us, even if you are not directly connected with the school. Your prayers and support really matter. St. Gabriel School is **our school**. Thanks be to God.

All our children and youth are so important to us because we are one family. I will be sharing more about our many **Faith Formation programs** in the coming weeks. For now, remember to register, and if you are able, to fill in the few remaining spots to help us share faith with our young people in effective and meaningful ways.



We invite, do our part, and let God do the rest. It truly is amazing. But, why wouldn’t it be? This is just what Jesus did.

I believe one of the most important things we can do as a parish is to just gather people together in a spirit of love, friendship and fun. Be aware that God is present among us at our calling. And then, let God do the rest. Helping people to make or strengthen **personal connections** accomplishes more spiritually and communally than we could ever measure. So, keep making those **personal connections in faith**, and be amazed at what God does. Have a great week. Summer isn’t over yet, so enjoy the sunshine and the goodness of God. Peace and blessings.

### LITURGY CORNER

This weekend’s readings are all about practicing and living your faith and not getting caught up in outward appearances and rituals. Jesus challenges the Pharisees, who were critical of Jesus for abandoning some of the Jewish rituals of the day, for clinging to human tradition and forgetting God’s own commandments. It’s not enough to just say we’re Christian and come to Mass on Sunday. We need to live the Gospel message every day. As Jesus tells the Pharisees in his quote from Isaiah, we can’t just honor Him with our lips, but must do so with our heart as well.

A perfect way to honor Jesus with your heart is to develop a relationship with Him. Do you have a relationship with Jesus where you can trust in Him, know Him, and feel His presence? Alpha is a great way to develop this relationship. Whether you’re coming from a position of being a lifelong Catholic or you have no faith background at all, Alpha teaches something to everyone. Our next series of Alpha starts next week, on September 7. There will be two sessions – a morning session at 9am and an evening at 7pm. Both are in-person in the Community Room. **CPAP Recall** Philips Respironics is voluntarily recalling some bilevel positive airway pressure (BiPAP) and continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) sleep apnea devices impacting approximately 2 million consumers in the US. These devices assist those with breathing difficulties (typically during sleep) by delivering pressure keeping the airways open. The concern with these recalled products is that a sound/vibration dampening foam in the devices may give off chemicals or break into particles small enough to be inhaled or ingested causing short or long term health problems. Owners of these Philips devices should consult their physician prior to discontinuing use. Benefits of continuing treatment may outweigh risks until a replacement can be obtained. If you own this product and have not received a recall notification letter, begin the recall process by visiting:


